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## Essilor Vision Foundation (EVF) Programs:

Kids Vision for Life focuses on providing vision services to children in need at no cost to the family through mobile clinics at the schools, school vision days, community vision fests, and other special events. Events include vision fests, health fairs, and many other summer program formats to allow our team the opportunity to provide hundreds of glasses in one day and educate the community about the importance of vision care. In 2012, KVFL screened more than 43,000 students and provided 15,329 pairs of new eyeglasses to kids in need at no cost to their families. Expenses incurred in 2012 totaled \$1,579,347.

Adopt a School (Essilor Employee Vision Days) provides employees an opportunity to give back to their local community by providing vision services at schools in their area as well as educating parents on the importance of good vision. In 2012, AAS screened more than 3,000 students and provided 669 pairs of new eyeglasses to students in need. Expenses incurred in 2012 totaled \$78,406

**Special Olympics** and EVF have a two decade partnership, where we provide both daily and sport-specific glasses to Special Olympic athletes.

Low-income children are much more likely to have vision problems that remain undiagnosed and have severe vision impairments at twice the normal rate. Approximately 50 percent of minority and poor children have vision problems that affect their academic performance. Uncorrected vision problems can have an enormous effect on school performance Children with poor vision have difficulty reading and seeing the board, leading to frustration and disengagement with school. In addition, young students with poor vision may have difficulty recognizing letters and learning to read.

Our programs were created after research revealed the critical relationship between a child's ability to see well and ability to read and learn to capacity. Furthermore, we found a direct relationship between uncorrected vision problems and academic underachievement, school dropout, and delinquency.

We believe that by connecting the dots between vision-literacy-education-society-economy, we are providing a solution to an unmet need.

Essilor Vision Foundation ("The Foundation") public support percentage over the last five years was 29.81%, short of the 33 1/3% threshold set forth in I.R.C. Section 170(b)(1)(A)(vi). As a result, The Foundation is relying on the facts and circumstances test as set forth in Treasury Regulation Section 1.170A-9(e)(3) to support its public charity status. To qualify under the facts and circumstances test, The Foundation must demonstrate the following two elements:

- 1. The total amount of public support must equal or exceed an absolute minimum of 10 percent of total support for the applicable period.
  - The Foundation's public support percentage for the five year period ended December 31, 2012 was 29.81%, well in excess of the minimum 10% threshold. The Foundation's public support percentage for the five year period ending December 31, 2013 is projected to be at least 33.3%, meeting the public support test.
- 2. The organization must be organized and operated to attract new and additional public support on a continuous basis. Treasury regulations state that "[a]n organization will be considered to meet this requirement if it maintains a continuous and bona fide program for solicitation of funds from the general public, community, or membership group involved...consideration will be given to whether the scope of its fundraising activities is reasonable in light of its charitable activities."

The Foundation understands that it must be more active in its fundraising, even in these trying economic times. The Foundation is committed to raising funds on a regular basis through both public solicitations and grants.

In addition to meeting both of the above requirements, all pertinent facts and circumstances surrounding the operations of the organization will be taken into consideration in determining whether this test is sufficiently satisfied. The Treasury regulations list five facts and circumstances that will be considered as important factors. An organization is not required to satisfy all of the factors, nor are the five factors listed exclusive - others may reasonably be considered such as the purpose of the organization and the length of time the organization has existed.
