MUEHLHAUSER, III**, as the initial Trustee, dated January 12, 2001, as amended and restated pursuant to a certain Restatement of Trust Agreement dated June 30, 2004, under which **THE CITIZENS BANKING COMPANY**, Sandusky, Ohio, currently is serving as the Successor Trustee, which Restated Trust Agreement was amended on January 26, 2005; and was further amended by Second Amendment to Restatement of Trust Agreement, dated January 12, 2006; and was further amended by Third Amendment of Restatement of Trust Agreement, dated September 1, 2006; hereby further amends said Restatement of Trust Agreement (referred to in this document as "the Trust Agreement") as follows:

- 1. I amend Paragraph IV.C., Subparagraph 2. (c) found of Page 5 of the Trust Agreement to provide in its entirety as follows:**

"(c) For each fiscal year of the Trust after my death, or if during my lifetime United Way shall violate the restriction on distributions set forth in Paragraph IV.C.2.(a) of this Agreement, or if during my lifetime United Way shall be dissolved or a bankruptcy filing or similar filing shall be made with respect to United Way, the amount otherwise distributable by the Trust to United Way pursuant to Paragraph IV.C.2.(a) of this Agreement

shall be distributed as follows: twelve percent (12.0%) thereof (which is three percent (3.0%) of the total) to A.T. STILL UNIVERSITY, or any successor thereto, to be used in such manner and for such purpose as the governing body thereof shall determine; twelve percent (12.0%) thereof (which is three percent (3.0%) of the total) to THE FIRELANDS SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA, or any successor thereto, to be used in such manner and for such purpose as the governing body thereof shall determine; twelve percent (12.0%) thereof (which is three percent (3.0%) of the total) to the SANDUSKY BOARD OF EDUCATION, Sandusky, Ohio, to be used in accordance with the provisions of subparagraph 4 of this Paragraph IV C; twelve percent (12.0%) thereof (which is three percent (3.0%) of the total) to the BOWLING GREEN STATE UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION, INC., to be used in accordance with the provisions of subparagraphs 5 (a) and (b) of this Paragraph IV C; twelve percent (12.0%) thereof (which is three percent (3.0%) of the total) to THE CITY OF SANDUSKY, OHIO, to be used in accordance with the provisions of subparagraphs 6 (a) and (b) of this Paragraph IV C; and forty percent (40.0%) thereof (which is ten percent (10.0%) of the total) shall be paid and distributed in accordance with the provisions of subparagraph 8 (a) by the Trustee to such organizations and/or governmental units exclusively for their public purposes as shall be designated from time to time, in accordance with Paragraph IV C subparagraph 8 (d), hereinafter set forth, by the Distribution Committee hereinafter named.”
