#### **Johnson County Community Foundation**

#### **Unrestricted Grants Program Policies**

The Johnson County Community Foundation is a tax-exempt public charity governed by a volunteer board of directors broadly representative of the Johnson County community. The Mission of the Community Foundation is to assist donors to build an enduring source of charitable assets to benefit our community; to provide responsible stewardship of gifts donated; to promote leadership in addressing community issues; to make grants in the fields of community service, social service, education, health, environment and the arts.

The Community Foundation holds a variety of funds that make grants to a broad range of charitable agencies and programs. Usually these grants are made from the investment income earned on permanently endowed funds.

These grant guidelines and policies apply only to the unrestricted philanthropic funds in the Community Foundation and not to those funds for which donors have directed the use of a particular fund to a specific charitable purpose. Those funds are administered separately.

#### **Annual Grants Program Procedures**

Only nonprofit charitable programs and projects that serve the Johnson County community are considered for funding. Grant information and applications can be obtained at the Foundation's office or by calling (317)738-2213.

### **Decision-making Process**

A committee made up of community volunteers and members of the Foundation's board of directors evaluates each application. Members are selected to represent the broad geographic and professional diversity of the Johnson County community. The Board of Directors makes every effort to appoint committee members who will be unbiased and fair in evaluating proposals. The Committee is made up of 5-7 people with the committee chair being a member of the Foundation board. Members will serve nonrenewable three-year terms beginning January 1, of current year. A previous member may be re-appointed to the committee after one year's absence.

Committee members may visit the applicants at their facilities or location where a project/program will occur, and may contact others familiar with the organization and the need which the application addresses. The applicant may also be asked to meet briefly with the committee to discuss the project.

After evaluation, the Committee makes recommendations to Board of Directors, to approve final funding awards.

Occasionally the Grants committee may suggest that a decision on an application be postponed.

Conflicts of Interest. Because board and committee members are active in the community, potential conflicts of interest may arise from time to time. It is the Foundation's policy to deal with any conflicts of interest as openly as possible. A conflict of interest is defined as any activity or interest that may cause bias for or against a particular grant being considered. Committee and board members will disclose in writing and discuss potential conflicts and answer relevant questions. Once a conflict is disclosed, members may, if appropriate (as determined by the Board or Committee), abstain from further consideration of a particular grant. (see Conflict of Interest Policy)

#### Grant Guidelines, Policies and Evaluation Criteria

#### Guidelines

Preference will be given to proposals that:

- Address priority community concerns
- Are change-oriented and problem-solving in nature
- Will have the greatest benefit per dollar granted
- Have the potential of leveraging additional grants from other sources such as government and other foundations
- Assist grant recipients to achieve certain objectives

#### **Policies**

- Grants will be made only to nonprofit charitable organizations.
- Grants will be made only to organizations that provide for a responsible nonprofit fiscal agent and adequate accounting procedures
- Grants will be made only for projects/programs that are certified in writing by the chair of the organization's government body.
- Grantees must submit final grant evaluations reports in a timely manner. If reports are delinquent from a previous grant current applications will not be considered.

#### The Foundation generally does not make grants for the following:

- Ongoing operating expenses except on a short-term basis when support is critical to the survival of a key agency or program
- Programs/equipment that were committed to prior to the grant application period
- Debt reduction
- Annual appeals or membership contributions
- To or for projects/organizations benefiting individuals or a few persons
- Travel expense for individuals or groups
- Support of public or private educational institutions or government agencies except in special situations where support is essential to projects/programs that meet critical community needs
- Religious purposes or programs requiring religious participation
- Political purposes
- Endowment building

#### **Evaluation**

In evaluating grant proposals the Foundation gives consideration to:

<u>Project Quality</u>: established community need, expected benefits, planning, similarity to other programs, reasonableness of budget and grant request, other expected funding sources, potential to leverage other grants.

<u>Community Impact</u>: number of people affected, potential impact, demonstrated community need/desire for the project, collaboration with other organizations, volunteer commitment to the project.

<u>Project Management</u>: staff and board experience, organizational ability to carry out the project, mission-appropriate, long-range plan for the project and the organization, future of the organization.

The Foundation also takes into account whether the Foundation has adequate resources to effectively respond to the request.

The Annual Grants Programs may change from time to time. Applicants are encouraged to contact the Community Foundation prior to submitting an application to be certain their proposal qualifies for funding.

# **Conflict of Interest Policy & Disclosure Statement**

It is hereby declared to be the policy of the Board of Directors of the Johnson County Community Foundation, Inc. (JCCF) that all members of the board and the board's committees avoid any conflict of interest, and to the extent possible, the appearance of a conflict of interest, between their personal interests and interests of the JCCF in dealing with any organization or individual having, or seeking to have, any relationship which results or may result in a conflict of interest with the JCCF. In order that this policy may be operationalized, the Board hereby declares:

- 1. All board and committee members shall disclose any potential conflict of interest at the earliest practicable time. Such disclosure shall be done at least annually and as situations present themselves during the year and shall become a matter of record.
- No board or committee member shall vote on any matter under consideration at a JCCF meeting in which said member has a possible conflict of interest. Said member may be counted in determining the meeting's quorum. Said member should be prepared to excuse himself or herself from the room while the matter is discussed and voted on. The minutes of such meeting shall reflect that a disclosure was made and that the member having a possible conflict of interest abstained from voting. The foregoing requirements shall not be construed as a prohibition against the member briefly stating his or her position on the matter, nor from answering any questions of other board members since his or her knowledge may be of assistance.
- 3. A board or committee member shall be considered to have a possible conflict of interest if: (a) said member or immediate family member has an existing or potential financial or other interest which impairs or might appear to impair such member's independent judgment in the discharge of his or her responsibilities to the JCCF; or (b) said member is aware that a member of his or her immediate family or any organization in which member or member of his or her immediate family is an office, director, employee, partner, trustee or controlling stockholder, has such existing or potential financial or other interest.
- 4. All candidates for membership on the board shall be advised of this policy prior to assuming their responsibilities as members.
