RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE FRED AND EVE SIMON CHARITABLE FOUNDATION

(Formerly, SIMON CHARITABLE FOUNDATION)

There being no members thereof, the board of directors of Simon Charitable Foundation, a Nebraska nonprofit corporation, hereby restate and amend in its entirety the Articles of Incorporation of said entity.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be "The Fred and Eve Simon Charitable Foundation".

ARTICLE II - PUBLIC BENEFIT

This corporation is a public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE III - NO MEMBERS

The corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE IV - REGISTERED OFFICE

The street address of the corporation's registered office, and the name of the registered agent at that office, is: Steven Bloch, 8748 Frederick Street, Omaha, Nebraska 68124.

ARTICLE V - PURPOSES

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to support and promote the arts, education, child care and all other charitable, religious, literary and scientific endeavors, which purposes the corporation shall accomplish by conducting or supporting activities for the benefit of, or to carry out the purposes of, Qualified Organizations. For purposes of these Restated Articles of Incorporation, a "Qualified Organization" is any organization organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, artistic, social, religious, literary or scientific purposes and for other purposes described in and the other purposes set forth in the preceding sentence which are described in Section 501(c)(3) and Section 509(a)(1) or (2) the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code").

The board of directors of the corporation from time to time shall select the specific Qualified Organizations which are to be benefited by, or the purposes of which shall be carried out by the activities of, the corporation; and no Qualified Organization (or other entity or person) shall have any specific right or entitlement to become or remain a beneficiary of the corporation to any extent or for any particular period of time.

References in these Restated Articles of Incorporation to sections of the Code, as amended, shall be deemed to include the comparable provisions of any subsequent internal revenue law of the United States of America which supersedes the Code.

ARTICLE VI - CERTAIN ACTIVITIES

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any director, officer or other private person; however, the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make other payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Restated Articles of Incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation; and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office. Without limiting the generality of any other provision of these Restated Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on or conduct any activities which are not permitted to be carried on or conducted by:

- (a) an organization which is exempt from federal income tax under Code Section 501(a) and which is other than a private foundation by reason of its being described in Code Section 509(a)(3), or
- (b) an organization contributions to which are deductible under Code Section 170(a).

ARTICLE VII - DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors of the corporation shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, distribute all of the assets of the corporation to any Qualified Organization, or if there is no such entity, then otherwise to a state or local government for public purposes and as the board of directors of the corporation shall determine. Any corporation assets not so distributed shall be disposed of by the County Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for the purposes set forth in Article V in such county and, as such County Court shall determine.

ARTICLE VIII - POWERS

The corporation shall have and possess all powers and rights conferred upon corporations by the Nebraska Nonprofit Corporation Act including the power to receive gifts, make donations and invest assets. In addition, the corporation shall have and may exercise all such other powers which are not denied to a public benefit corporation by Nebraska law as are necessary, proper, convenient or expedient to the attainment of the purposes set forth in these Restated Articles of Incorporation and the powers set forth herein.

ARTICLE IX - EXEMPT STATUS

It is intended that the corporation shall have the status of an organization which is exempt from federal income tax under Code Section 501(a) as an organization which is described in Code Section 501(c)(3) and which is other than a private corporation by reason of being described in Code Section 509(a)(3). These Restated Articles of Incorporation, and all powers conferred on, and activities of, the corporation, shall be limited and construed accordingly.

ARTICLE X - DIRECTORS

The business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a board of directors. The board of directors of the corporation as of the date of these Restated Articles of Incorporation is as follows:

ARTICLE XI - NO PERSONAL LIABILITY

No director or officer of the corporation shall be liable for the debts, liabilities or obligations of the corporation, and the private property of each such person shall not be subject to the payment of any debts of the corporation. The corporation shall indemnify each person who is serving, or who has

served, as a director or officer of the corporation in accordance with and to the maximum extent permitted under Nebraska law. Moreover, any person who serves, or who has served, as a director or officer of the corporation shall be indemnified by the corporation against any civil liability for any act or omission which results in damages or injury if such person was acting within the scope of his or her official function and duties as a director or officer of the corporation (unless such damage or injury was caused by the willful or wanton act or omission of such director or officer).

ARTICLE XII - AMENDMENT

All amendments of these Restated Articles of Incorporation must be approved by both a majority of the directors of the corporation then in office.
