	The Ark is located in Kalamazoo and is the only short-term crisis intervention shelter serving youth ages 10-17 in the nine counties
	served by the Diocese of Kalamazoo. The Ark serves youth who have run away; are in danger of being homeless; or are experiencing
	a crisis. Youth stay up to 21 days and receive counseling, support services, and aftercare services at no charge. The goal is to unite
	and strengthen families. In 2012, the Ark shelter served 217 runaway and homeless youth and provided 2,356 days of care. The Ark Community Services program helps homeless youth ages 16-21 to find housing, complete their education, and find employment. In
	2012, they provided 4381 hours of counseling and case management services and 8123 days of housing assistance to 63 youth. The
	Ark Outreach program helps homeless youth on the streets; offers free education and prevention workshops in schools and other
	organizations and helps to promote the Ark services. In 2012, staff made 257 presentations, and provided 399 hours of crisis
	intervention services to 1,172 youth. Through community support, assistance in the form of household items valued at \$6,862,
	were distributed to eligible youth served through these programs.

	mortality screening and education; family literacy programs; material items; adoption counseling and transitional housing In 2012, Caring Network provided 904 sessions of case management to 76 women; provided prevention and support services to
	472 women; plus briefly assisted 34 additional women. 7 adults and 4 babies spent a total of 1,424 days of residence in the
	Caring Network apartments. 68 Post adoption contacts were made and 10 cases were opened. Caring Network also provides
	supportive in-home services to families in Kalamazoo, Cass and St. Joseph counties, through a partnership with the State of
	Michigan Department of Human Services. Through community support, assistance in the form of clothing, furniture,
	household items, car seats, cribs, diapers, and holiday gift baskets valued at \$50,692 were given to eligible clients.

All requests for client assistance reviews and approves all expenditures based on funding levels and compliance with grant budgets, the agency also complies with all requests for audits and reviews by funding bodies and has had no significant compliance findings in 2012; ensuring appropriate use of these funds. Each program also provides training to direct service, management, and administrative require specific documentation; including the client number, to track expenditures to specific grants and client case files and the program supervisor's approval.
