- Culture and the Arts programs that create a wider recognition of Michigan's cultural assets, build new audiences, provide services to regions or populations who would otherwise be unable to participate and demonstrate significant involvement on the part of business or community leaders.

The Foundation will consider requests from qualified organizations to support operating budgets and capital fund programs for the construction, refurbishment or purchase of buildings, structures, equipment or physical enhancements. Normally, the foundation will not contribute to endowments.

#### Volunteer Investment Program

Through the Volunteer Investment Program, the Foundation awards grants to nonprofit organizations on behalf of employee and retiree volunteers.
