The Foundation will award up to seven college scholarships, valued at up to \$2,500 per year for four successive years toward tuition costs *only*, at an accredited college or university of your choice. One of the seven scholarships, the William S West Scholarship, is made possible through a gift to the Foundation from Mr. West's family in memory of our former Chairman and Chief Executive Officer. It-is-also important for you to know that if you are selected as a recipient of a scholarship, you must enter college by the fall of the year in which the scholarship is awarded and continue for four successive years in college without interruption, except for usual vacation periods or active duty military training or service.
