NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2011

Note 1 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

<u>Nature of Activities</u> Luverne Area Community Foundation (the Corporation) was formed as a nonprofit organization. The purpose for which the Corporation was organized was to develop financial resources so as to guarantee and assist in providing community benefits to all persons in the area served. The Corporation's support comes primarily from individual donor's contributions.

Method of Accounting The financial statements of the Corporation have been prepared utilizing the accrual basis of accounting. Using this method, revenues are recognized when earned and expenses are recognized when incurred.

<u>Financial Statement Presentation</u> The Corporation has presented its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles for not-for-profit organizations. Under this guidance, the Corporation is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets. In addition, the Corporation is required to present a statement of cash flows.

<u>Promises to Give</u> Contributions are recognized when the donor makes a promise to give to the Corporation that is, in substance, unconditional. Contributions that are restricted by the donor are reported as increases in unrestricted net assets if the restrictions expire in the fiscal year in which the contributions are recognized. All other donor-restricted contributions are reported as increases in temporarily or permanently restricted net assets depending on the nature of the restrictions. When a restriction expires, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets.

<u>Investments</u> The Corporation carries investments at their fair values in the statement of financial position. Realized and unrealized gains and losses for investments are recorded in the statement of activities.

<u>Fair Value of Financial Instruments</u> The carrying amounts of cash, certificates of deposit, taxes payable and grants payable approximate fair market values because of the short maturities of those instruments.

<u>Cash Flows</u> For purposes of the cash flow statement, the Corporation considers all cash and investments with a maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2011

Note 1 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies-continued

<u>Income Taxes</u> The Organization is a not-for-profit organization as described in Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is exempt from federal income taxes.

The Organization's Forms 990, Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax, are subject to examination by the IRS, generally for three years after they are filed.

<u>Use of Estimates</u> The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Note 4 Concentration of Credit Risk

The Corporation maintains its cash accounts in banks. Accounts at each bank are guaranteed by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC). The Corporation has not experienced any losses in such accounts and believes they are not exposed to any significant credit risk on cash balances.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2011

Note 5 Restrictions on Net Assets

Temporarily restricted net assets are recorded as unconditional promises to give due to the inherent time restrictions of these receivables.

Unrestricted net assets of Luverne Area Community Foundation amounted to \$1,706,533 for the year ended December 31, 2011. Although grant recommendations are accepted from the donors or other advisors of these funds, the Corporation has ultimate discretion of those funds.

Note 6 Grants Payable

Unconditional grants are recognized as an expense in the period in which they are approved by the board of directors. All grants payable as of December 31, 2011 are expected to be paid in less than one year.

Note 7 Subsequent Events

Management has evaluated subsequent events to May 9, 2012, the date which the financial statements were available to be issued, and determined that no reportable events occurred.
