All individuals inquring about donating or receiving winter clothing were referred to New Hope Part III, Line 4d - Other Program Services Designated Gifts: Expenses (all Grants) - \$51,172 - United Way of Mahaska County accepts designated donations from donors during the annual fundraising campaign. Donations are forwarded to designated human services 501(c) agencies. Special Grants: Expenses (all Grants) - \$28,050 - United Way of Mahaska County provided Special Grants to 9 local agencies. Programs funded included basic needs & survivor assistance, literacy programming, agency equipment and disaster supplies. Capacity Building Series: Expenses - \$1,929 - United Way of Mahaska County hosted a series of seminars for its agencies and other local non-profits. These seminars were geared toward offering information to improve effectiveness in management of a small non-profit and provided an opportunity for local agencies to share ideas. Operation Backpack: Expenses - \$1,808 - Each fall, United Way of Mahaska County helps children of low income families by providing the necessary supplies for the upcoming school year. Any child, preschool through 12th grade, is eligible for assistance in this program. In 2012, we supplied over 300 backpacks to children in Mahaska County. Leftover supplies were given to local schools to stock school supply closets to be utilized by teachers throughout the school year. We partnered with SIEDA, Love In the Name of Christ, Salvation Army, and the school districts in Mahaska County. VITA Tax Site: Expenses - \$321 - United Way of Mahaska County recruits volunteers, coordinates and hosts a VITA Tax Preparatio Assistance Site. IRS Certified VITA Tax Preparers provide free tax preparation for low income families and individuals. Volunteer Appreciation Open House: Expenses - \$144 - Once a year, we take the opportunity to give something back to all of the volunteers that give of their time each year to our United Way and to our funded agencies.
