Mct Avi Mizrachi the Director of Dugit Street Ministry and Senior pastor, Adonai Roi, in Tel Aviv. Dugit is in a new downtown location with greater access to the local residents on a very busy intersection. Avi also Pastors the Adoni Roi congregation which is very active in outreach and witness.

KAM Jerusalem Witness to the Jewish people

Met with Victor Smadja and he gave me an update on current activities. As always, I look forward to my time with Victor, a superb Bible scholar dedicated to teaching and witness to the Jewish people. KAM prints, binds and distributes books & literature "free" to Jews throughout Israel.

Bethlehem Bible College

Met with Dr Bishara Awad, President Bethlehem Bible College, Alex Awad, Dean, & the administrative staff at Bethlehem Bible College. Reviewed current activities and toured the recently completed new BBC building that has classrooms, a lecture and conference auditorium & computer labs. Bishara visited Joplin June 2011 to tour the tornado destruction area. He also visited with families, prayed for volunteers & met with City leaders.

Shepherds Society Bethlehem BBC

Shepherds Society oversees the Families program that CWP provides support for Christian families at \$50 monthly since 1997. Met with the Director George Abade and reviewed activities and funding. The Shepherds Society at BBC meets a vital need in the Bethlehem community.

Beit Asaph Congregation Natanya

We met Evan Thomas, Pastor Beit Asaph & gave a gift for ministry. Our meeting took place in Bethlehem where a major conference was in session. 600 people from around the world attended focusing on the Middle East. Evan was a keynote speaker here at the conference discussing the Messianic movement in Israel. Evans church in Natanya Israel is very active in evangelism and outreach to the Jewish people.

Jerusalem Assembly Congregation

We attend the Saturday morning services at Jerusalem Assembly where Victor Smadja is the Senior Elder and Pastor.
