During the calendar year of 2012 RLC provided 5204 counseling visits. In addition, RLC provided \$302,520 in donated services to those unable to pay.

RLC had 5204 visits during 2012 which was an increase of 637 visits over last years visits. RLC gave away \$302,520 in donated services to those who could not afford to pay for counseling or could only pay at a reduced rate based upon our established sliding fee scale. RLC continues to see an increase of individuals and families counseling in large part due to our challenging times and current economy and the stress it continues to place on lives in our community. Many of the RLC clients received valuable marriage counseling that was instrumental in the saving of marriages and families. RLC also continued with the Outreach Program counseling service (in home visits) for demestic violence and severe family issues. In addition, RLC continued to provide probono visits to the homeless who reside in the care program of the Rescue Mission. RLC also continued to provide counseling to women who are being treated for drug and alcohol problems and are living in the Walter Hoving Home.

RLC continued with the Spiritual Formation purpose in which classes in Transforming Lives and Bible Institute were offered during 2012.
