This amount represents over 25% of the Foundation's net assets of \$10,000 (as measured by fair market value) on the day that the Foundation received its initial endowment in the Foundation's taxable year ending December 31, 2012

Although the Foundation technically experienced a "substantial contraction," it will continue in existence and has no plans for dissolution.

The Foundation made distributions of cash to the grantees listed in the attachment to Part XV, Line 3a, each such grant was made solely for the chantable purpose specified therein.
