The Trust document of the M Street Foundation (the "Foundation") was signed by the donors on November 28, 2012 and was not funded until August 2014. The tax determination letter from the Internal Revenue Service was received on May 15, 2014, effective November 12, 2012.

The Foundation was created to receive a share of the assets previously held by the Marshall B. Coyne Foundation, Inc., a tax-exempt private foundation.

No returns have previously been filed, since the foundation (a trust) had not yet been funded and the application for exemption was pending. However, since the foundation has now been approved retroactively to November 12, 2012 the foundation is filing returns for 2012 and 2013 in order to meet the reporting requirements for a private foundation.

For the reasons set forth above, we respectfully request a waiver of any penalties for late filing. The omission was not intentional and there is no excise tax due.
