AS A RESULT, NET INVESTMENT INCOME HS DECREASED BY \$5,034 AND EXPENSES FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES HAS DECREASED BY \$5,337. FEDERAL INCOME TAXES OF \$303 ARE INCLUDED ONLY AS AN EXPENSE PER BOOKS. THESE CHANGES HAVE REDUCED THE CURRENT YEAR INCOME TAX LIABILITY BY \$101 AND REDUCED THE EXCESS DISTRIBUTION CARRYOVER TO 2013 BY \$7,416.
