Part V, Line 2(1): The reporting organization received grants from the CADCO Foundation to support operation of the organization's
business incubator building. Total grants received in 2012 were \$67,284.
Part V, Line 2(2): The reporting organization loaned \$67,654 in 2012 to Enterprise Properties, Inc. to assist with paying off a mortage balance
owed by Enterprise Properties to an unrelated entity.
Part V, Line 2(3): The reporting organization owed two separate notes payable to the CADCO Foundation. These funds were borrowed from
the Foundation's board-designated endowment for the purpose of improvement to the business incubator building owned and operated by
the reporting organization. Funds are repaid monthly to the Foundation's endowment, based on amortization schedules computed with
competitive fixed rates. In 2011 (\$52,025) and 2012 (\$234,194), the CADCO Foundation advanced a total of \$286,219 for major build out of the
business incubator's unfinished fourth floor. Construction was completed in 2012, and a repayment plan was developed. At 12/31/12, total
notes payable to the CADCO Foundation, including new construction advances were \$354,455. Total payments to the CADCO Foundation
on prior notes payable were \$32,853 in 2012.
Part V, Line 2(4): The reporting organization receives monthly rental income from the Interregional Chamber of Commerce for
reimbursement of occupancy costs in support of Chamber activities. Total rents received from the Chamber in 2012 were \$5,616.
Part V, Line 2(5): The reporting organization received nominal membership dues totaling \$725 from CADCO Foundation and Enterprise
Properties. All administrative and management functions of the related organizations are performed by staff of the reporting organization
without charge to CADCO Foundation, at cost to the Chamber and for an annual management fee of \$48,000 to Enterprise Properties.
Part V, Line 2(6): As with many related organizations managed by shared staff and utilizing shared resources, CADCO Foundation,
Enterprise Properties and the Interregional Chamber of Commerce use intercompany due to/from accounts with the reporting organization
to capture transfers and other transactions during the normal course of recordkeeping. The net increase in the Foundation's payable to the
reporting organization in 2012 was \$31,764. The net decrease in Enterprise Properties' payable to the reporting organization in 2012 was
\$299. The net increase in the Chamber's receivable from the reporting organization in 2012 was \$12,413.
