The Weatherspoon Foundation timely filed its 2012 Federal return, Form 990-PF. During the course of preparing the 2015 return, it was discovered that a dividend and a capital gain were inadvertently omitted from the return. Accordingly, the Foundation is now reporting the additional income and paying the additional tax due.

The Internal Revenue Service's purpose/philosophy in assessing penalties as set forth in Part 21(122) of The Consolidated Penalty Handbook of the Internal Revenue Manual states that the fundamental reason for having penalties is to support and encourage voluntary compliance. Other results may arise, such as bringing additional revenues into the Treasury, imposing monetary charges against taxpayers, and, to a certain extent, getting reimbursed for enforcement costs. However, these other results should not be the basis for creating or imposing a penalty.

Likewise, Internal Revenue Policy Statement P-1-18 provides that "Penalties support the Service's mission only if penalties enhance voluntary compliance."(Emphasis added.) Therefore, it is clear that the purpose behind penalties is to support, encourage, and enhance voluntary compliance. It is also clear that this goal is not advanced by assessing a penalty against the Taxpayer. As the Foundation has timely filed all returns and has made all other deposits as required, a penalty will not serve to further promote voluntary compliance on the part of the Taxpayer and reasonable cause exists for abatement of the penalty.

In addition, there was no willful intent on the part of the Foundation to disregard the filing requirements, reporting of income, or payment of tax, and when it was discovered that the additional tax was required, the Foundation amended its prior year returns immediately.

The Foundation believes that these circumstances constitute reasonable cause and respectfully requests that any late payment believes be abated.
