


Description: Necklace. Red glass beads, different sizes, West Africa, Door2a 048




Description: Necklace, single strand of large globe beads, clear and translucent colored glass, Africa, Door2a 090








Description: Necklace, single strand, tubular beads, clear glass, \$ design, Africa, Door2a 093




Description: Necklace, single long strand, tubular 'gooseberry' beads, Africa, Door2a 095








Description: Necklace, single strand of large bicone 'vaseline' beads, translucent green, Africa, Door2a 097




Description: Necklace, single strand of yellow 'hebron' beads, Africa, Door2a 106










Description: Necklace, single strand of short yellow tube beads with a brass pendant, cruciform design, Africa, Door2a 118








Description: Necklace, single strand of faux snake vertebrae, cobalt glass or plastic, Africa, Door2a 125




Description: Necklace, single strand of glass rondelles, green, Africa, Door2a 127








Description: Necklace, single strand of short cylindrical glass beads in green, Africa, Door2a 130




Description: Necklace, single strand of stone beads, multiple shapes, Africa, Door2a 131








Description: Necklace, single strand of recycled glass beads in greens, blues, Africa, Door2a 135




Description: Necklace, single strand of recycled glass beads, green alternating with smaller striped 'krobo' beads, Africa, Door2a 136








Description: Necklace, single strand of glass beads in multiple shapes, blues, Africa, Door2a 138




Description: Necklace, single strand of barrel shaped glass beads, teal blue color, Africa, Door2a 139




