#### Note 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Organization and Nature of Activities

The South Carolina Junior Golf Foundation is a non-profit organization as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is exempt from federal and state income taxes. The Organization's federal Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Returns (Form 990) for the years 2009, 2010 and 2011 are subject to examination by the IRS, generally for three years after they were filed.

The Organization was formed in 1995 in the state of South Carolina.

The purpose of the Organization is to introduce the game of golf and its values to positively affect young people and to provide opportunities for the continued growth and involvement in the game of golf and also to provide scholarships to junior golfers to attend a college or university of their choice.

Funds are generated from individual contributions, corporate donations and various fundraising events.

The management of all the affairs, properties and work of the Organization is vested in a Board of Trustees that are residents of the State of South Carolina.

#### **Basis of Accounting**

The financial statements have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting and accordingly reflects all significant receivables, payables, and other liabilities.

#### **Basis of Presentation**

Financial statement presentation follows the recommendations of the Financial Accounting Standards Board in current Financial Accounting Standards of Not-for-Profit Organizations. Under those standards, the Organization is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: Unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

#### **Estimates**

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### Note 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (Continued)

#### Revenue Recognition

Contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted, or permanently restricted support, depending on the existence and/or nature of any donor restrictions.

All donor-restricted contributions are reported as an increase in temporarily or permanently restricted net assets, depending on the nature of the restriction. When a donor restriction expires, that is, when a stipulated time restriction ends or purpose restriction is accomplished, temporarily restricted net assets are reclassified to unrestricted net assets and reported in the statement of activities as net assets released from restrictions.

Unconditional promises to give are recorded as revenue and are recorded at their net realizable value.

#### Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include all monies on hand and in banks and highly liquid investments with maturity dates of less than three months. The carrying value of cash and cash equivalents approximate fair value because of the short maturities of those financial instruments.

#### **Investments**

Investments are composed of certificates of deposit, corporate bonds and equity securities. The investments in marketable securities with readily determinable fair values and all investments in debt securities are reported at their fair values based on quoted prices in active markets (all Level 1 measurements) in the statement of financial position. Unrealized gains and losses are included in the change in net assets. Investment income and gains restricted by a donor are reported as increases in unrestricted net assests if the restrictions are met (either by passage of time or by use) in the reporting period in which the income and gains are recognized.

#### Note 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (Continued)

#### **Property and Equipment**

Property and Equipment consists of office equipment and is recorded at cost. The equipment is being depreciated over an estimated useful life of five years using the straight line method. Depreciation expense for the year was \$800.

#### Advertising

The Foundation expenses advertising costs as incurred. Advertising expense for the year was \$2,900.

#### Note 2. INVESTMENTS

Investment securities are carried at fair value based on quoted prices in active markets (all level 1 measurements, which are quoted prices in active markets for identical assets) and consist of the following at December 31, 2012:

#### Note 5. RETIREMENT PLAN

The Foundation employees participate in a group retirement plan for the Foundation, South Carolina Junior Golf Association, and the South Carolina Golf Association. The contribution to the plan by the Foundation for the year was \$1,580.

#### Note 6. RELATED PARTIES

The Foundation provides funding to the SC Junior Golf Association to help carry out many of the programs of the foundation. For the year 2012, total funding to the SC Junior Golf Association was \$175,000.

#### Note 7. CONCENTRATIONS OF CREDIT RISK

At various times during the year, the Organization's cash in bank balances exceeded the federally insured limits. At December 31, 2012, all of the Foundation's cash balances were federally insured.

#### Note 8. DATE OF MANAGEMENT'S REVIEW

Subsequent events have been evaluated through May 30, 2013 which is the date financial statements were available to be issued.
