NOTE A: SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

Organization

International Society of Nephrology is a 501(c)3 organization, a not-for-profit corporation, which was incorporated in Pennsylvania in July, 2003. The organization operated in Virginia and is now located in Cranford, New Jersey, effective January 1, 2012.

Nature of Business

The Society is a professional organization whose mission is the prevention of kidney disease in the developing countries and the developed countries. The organization teaches and trains doctors in less advanced countries to diagnose, treat, and prevent kidney disease.

Basis of Accounting

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain requested amounts of assets, liabilities, and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimated.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

For financial statement purposes, cash and money market accounts invested in cash (not mutual funds) are cash equivalents.

Receivables

The receivables are stated at their net realizable value. When collection efforts are exhausted, past due accounts are analyzed to determine if they are collectible. Receivables deemed uncollectible are written off to bad debt expense. As management estimates that all receivables are fully collectible, there has been no allowance for doubtful accounts established. This is an exception to generally accepted accounting principles in the United States of America. A bad debt was recorded in the amount of \$9,026 for a receivable of value added tax which was not collectible.

Prepaid Expenses

These are expenses paid in advance for future meetings and are expensed at the time when the event takes place.

Grants Payable

When the Society approves the grant, the grant payable is recorded.

Net Assets

The Society's net assets are classified into three categories.

1. (a) <u>Unrestricted</u> – Operating

Net Assets with no donor-imposed restrictions whereby the resources are available for the general support of the society's operations

(b) Unrestricted - Board Designated Endowment

This category represents a portion of unrestricted net assets that have been designated by the Board of Governance of the society to be held in perpetuity for the use of the Barbra L. & Robert W. Schrier Fund for the purpose of Global Development of Nephrology.

2. Temporarily Restricted

This category represents funds received by the Society from contributions that have a specific purpose or have a time restriction imposed on the contribution by the donor.

3. Permanently Restricted

This category represents endowment funds (The Barbra L. and Robert W. Schrier Fund for Global Development in Nephrology and ISN-India Committee – SHRI Indukaka Ipcowala Endowment Fund) held in perpetuity by the society. Investment income earned on these funds is temporarily restricted for the purpose of supporting renal prevention programs and/or education in nephrology programs in developing countries.

Revenue Recognition

Revenue and costs are recorded by the accrual basis of accounting as required by generally accepted accounting principles used in the United States of America.

Publication revenue is recognized when the services are provided. Membership revenue is recognized as revenue in the year the membership is received. Revenue for meetings is recognized on the date the event occurs. Amounts received in advance of the event are recorded as deferred revenue until the event occurs.

Contributions are recorded as revenue upon receipt of the contribution or when a donor promises to give the society an unconditional gift. Restricted contributions by a donor are listed as an increase in either temporarily restricted or permanently restricted net assets. Upon expiration of a temporary restriction or when the temporary restriction is fulfilled, the temporarily restricted net assets are then reclassified to unrestricted net assets.

Restrictions that are met in the same period that they were received are classified as unrestricted revenue in the accompanying Statement of Activities. Revenue is

recorded in categories in accordance with exempt function, such as unrelated business revenue and other revenue excluded from income tax.

Functional Allocation of Expenses

The Society's costs are summarized by category for programs and services, management and general, and total expenses. There are no fundraising expenses. Direct expenses are charged to the activities based on specific identification. Indirect costs are allocated to programs and services or management and general based on the estimated time taken for the activities.

Foreign Currency

The currency used by the society for its financial statements is the U.S. dollar. Some of the Society's revenue is received in Euros and some of the expenses are paid in Euros. There are transaction gains and losses recorded accordingly. The net foreign exchange loss for the period ended December 31, 2012 is \$11,335. This is listed in the financial statements as an other item not included in operations.

Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act

The entity moved its offices from Virginia to New Jersey. New Jersey has adopted the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA). Under the act, unappropriated endowment fund assets are considered restricted. In the Endowment Fund of the society, \$160,000 is Board Designated Endowment Fund in the Unrestricted Fund. For the purpose of this act, these funds are considered restricted until appropriated.

Fair Value Financial Statements

Investments are recorded at their fair value, which is the amount at which that investment could be bought or sold in a current transaction between willing parties.

NOTE B: CREDIT RISK:

The organization has investments held with Vanguard. As of December 31, 2012, investment in mutual funds invested in stocks and bonds had a fair value of \$9,486,215. These investments are not FDIC insured.

NOTE C: ADVERTISING EXPENSE:

There was a credit for advertising in the amount of \$1,363 for an over accrual from the year ended December 31, 2011.

NOTE D: UNCERTAIN TAX POSITIONS:

As described in Note A, the Organization's income tax returns for 2006-2012 are subject to examination by the IRS, usually for three years after they are filed. In addition, the Organization's state returns are subject to examination by state tax authorities for similar time periods.

NOTE E: INVESTMENTS:

Investments are recorded at fair value and consist of the following. They are categorized as Level 1 in the Fair Value Hierarchy as their value is based on unadjusted quoted prices for the investments which are actively traded in the market.

NOTE F: INCOME TAXES:

The Society of is exempt from federal income taxes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as an organization. It is not a private foundation.

The Society follows the accounting standards regarding recognition and measurement if uncertain tax positions exist and determined that its positions are more likely than not to be sustained upon examination. The Society's tax returns are subject to review and examination by federal and state authorities. The tax returns for the years ended 2006 - 2012 are open for examination by federal and state authorities. In 2011, the returns for 2006 through 2008 were amended to reflect advertising income as unrelated business income. The related taxes were paid in 2011. In the year ended December 31, 2012, interest expenses were paid to the United States Treasury for the years ended:

2010 in the amount of \$4,567.76,

2009 in the amount of \$17,242.77, and

2008 in the amount of \$8,736.53.

With a small credit being returned to the Organization in the amount of \$(87).

NOTE G: RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS:

The International Society of Nephrology pays 70,000 euros monthly to a related organization, The International Society of Nephrology Foundation, for rent, office expenses, and compensation for its Brussels Office which furnishes management services to the Organization. In addition, they pay any invoice for the society which includes value added tax.

The following individuals are on both the International Society of Nephrology's Board and the International Society of Nephrology Foundation:

NOTE H: ENDOWMENTS:

The Society classifies assets into the following categories:

- 1. Permanently Restricted are gifts that are required to be held for the long term.
- 2. Temporarily restricted are a) Earnings on Permanently Restricted Net Assets until these assets are used by the society or b) Temporarily Restricted Grants that are gifts to the Society for a specific purpose.
- 3. Unrestricted when the funds are released from their restrictions to be used by the Society.

The endowment fund's policy for investment is to make sure the principal is protected, to earn return on investments, and obtain a reasonable growth rate. Below is a table showing the value of the net assets in the endowment assets for the year ended December 31, 2012 as follows:

The amount of rent for the subtenant is \$500 per month for 2012, \$520 per month for 2013, \$540 per month for 2014, \$550 per month for 2015, and \$575 per month for 2016.
