supporting documentation. Applications are reviewed and approved by a supervisor. The Executive Director approves payments and signs checks made payable directly to the landlord vendor. Local bus passes and gas cards are purchased in advance by each respective Division Director. These passes and gas cards are distributed to eligible clients according to need. Other assistance includes helping clients secure identification cards and copies of birth certificates so they can obtain employment. A case manager personally interviews clients or utility company on behalf of the client. Patient prescriptions are written by the nurse practitioner manager or volunteer and are processed and invoiced through a single pharmacy Grants paid on behalf of individuals are regularly monitored throughout the year based on board-approved budget. Applications for rent and utility assistance are completed including

and assesses their need for help. In some cases payments are made online by credit card, and in other cases payment is made through a requisition of petty cash. Each purchase is

recorded by the case manager on a spreadsheet with identifying information, type of assistance, and the amount.

Clothing vouchers issued through the Outreach Services Divison of the organization are fulfilled at the stores.
