BYLAWS

THE FAIRHOPE SINGLE TAX CORPORATION ADOPTED JUNE 12, 2012

1.0 PRESIDENT:

- 1.1 Upon consultation with the Executive Council, will submit names of nominees for all Committees to the Executive Council for their approval at the second meeting of the Executive Council following the annual election.
- 1.2 May delegate authority and assign duties to other members of the office staff, or to other officer's members, or committees.
 - 1.3 Is the spokesperson for the organization.

2.0 VICE PRESIDENT:

2.1 Shall perform the duties of President in his or her absence, and also perform such specific duties as may be assigned by the Executive Council.

3.0 TREASURER:

- 3.1 Checks may be signed by any two of the following three officers: Treasurer, President, and Secretary. It is suggested that the Treasurer be one of the two signatories.
- 3.2 In the absence of the President and the Vice President, the Treasurer may chair the Executive Council meeting.

4.0 SECRETARY:

- 4.1 Will serve as Office Manager and administrator, responsible for the daily operation and supervision of the staff.
- 4.2 Shall take and maintain minutes of the Executive Council meetings. In the absence of the Secretary the Executive Council shall appoint someone to take the minutes.
- 4.3 Will be responsible for publishing standard operating policies (SOP) adopted by the Directors.

5.0 EXECUTIVE COUNCIL:

5.1 Will meet once a month at a day and time to be determined by the Executive Council. A majority of the Directors can change the date of a meeting in case of conflict. The President or a majority of the Directors can call a special meeting.

5.2 Three Members shall constitute a quorum at any regular or special meeting

6.0 COMMITTEES:

6.1 All members, including a non-voting Director liaison, are nominated by the President and approved by the Executive Council. All committees shall have at least three members. Appropriations for the expenses of any Committee require approval by the Executive Council.

7.0 MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE:

- 7.1 Shall be responsible for establishing procedures for applying for membership in FSTC, including preparing a petition, to be approved by the Executive Council, for each prospective member to fill out.
- 7.2 Shall review the petition and interview prospective members to assure they are familiar with the single tax concept and the Fairhope Single Tax Corporation.
- 7.3 Shall make a recommendation to the Executive Council concerning acceptance of the applicant.
- 7.4 Upon acceptance to membership, and after thirty days have elapsed, the petitioner-member shall contribute to the FSTC the sum set forth by FSTC, and appear before the Executive Council where at that time the petitioner shall be administered the Oath which embodies and includes a pledge to support the aims, purposes, and principles.

8.0 EDUCATION COMMITTEE:

8.1 Shall be responsible for organizing and conducting classes in single tax principles and FSTC operation, and may recommend additional educational projects to the Executive Council.

9.0 RENT STUDY COMMITTEE:

9.1 Shall develop rent determination procedures for the Executive Council's consideration. Shall continuously observe the various changes in developments on and around lands of FSTC, and shall conduct such studies and surveys as may be necessary and required to estimate the effect of changes in values of the various parcels of FSTC land, to the end that fair and reasonable rent assessments may be recommended to the Executive Council for consideration in their rental determinations.

10.0 FINANCE COMMITTEE:

- 10.1 The Treasurer shall serve as Chair of the Committee.
- 10.2 Shall be responsible for estimating the needs for reserve funds and for

recommending investment of such funds.

11.0 SPECIAL COMMITTEES:

11.1 May be created for the performance of specific tasks.

12.0 CEMETERY COMMITTEE:

12.1 Shall have charge of the Colony Cemetery and all facilities thereupon; shall be responsible for care and maintenance of the grounds, trees, shrubbery, driveways, and all appurtenances of the site. Costs and expenses for maintenance work and improvements shall be paid from the income derived from the Fairhope Colony Cemetery Fund unless the Executive Council decides that additional funding is necessary. The Committee shall give an annual accounting of receipts and expenditures to the Trustees of said Fund.

13.0 DISMISSAL OF OFFICERS:

- 13.1 If the procedure for dismissal of an officer is commenced pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Constitution, the question of dismissal of the officer shall be decided by a popular vote of the members which shall be conducted at the time and place set by the Executive Council, or by the Trustees if the Executive Council fails to do so. Notice of the voting, and the form of the ballot for the voting, shall conform to the practices used in elections of officers. The voting shall be by secret ballot, and a majority of those voting shall be required for dismissal.
- 13.2 Following a dismissal action, the membership shall be promptly notified of the dismissal and of the election for the purpose of filling the vacancy. The election shall be governed by Article VII of the Constitution.

14.0 ELECTIONS and CONDUCT OF VOTING:

- 14.1 Elections shall be the responsibility of the Trustees who shall open and close the place of voting, identify each Member who is permitted to vote, keep suitable records of those Members who vote, notify the president of the results immediately, and make a written report to the Executive Council the following day. Trustees shall be present at all times of voting and if not available to be present Trustees must appoint other Members as substitutes.
- 14.2 Prior to each election, or on occasions when balloting is to be done, the Secretary shall prepare a list of all members on the membership records who are qualified and entitled to vote thereat, and shall deliver such list to the Trustees.
 - 14.3 Each Member shall be given adequate time to cast a ballot.
- 14.4 The balloting place shall not be open to visitors or Members, except those voting or conducting the election, until after the voting place is closed, votes are counted and the results are ready for delivery to the President and the Executive Council.
 - 14.5 The place of balloting and elections shall be in the Library Room of FSTC or

such other suitable place as the Executive Council should fix for the purpose. The place of election shall be open for the casting of ballots between the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. and from 3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.

15.0 AMENDMENTS:

- 15.1 Amendments to these bylaws may be made at any time by resolution when approved by unanimous vote of the Executive Council, or at any regular meeting by a resolution adopted by a majority vote provided notice of the proposed amendment is sent by mail to all members of the Executive Council and the President at least one week in advance of the meeting.
- 15.2 The Executive Council shall cause an annual review to be made with a view toward making needed changes to the bylaws.

16.0 EFFECTIVE DATE and AUTHORITY:

- 16.1 These bylaws shall upon their adoption by the Executive Council, supersede any previous bylaws.
- 16.2 It is recognized that in the event of a conflict between these bylaws and the FSTC Constitution that the Constitution shall prevail. A ruling that declares any individual part of these bylaws to be in conflict with the Constitution shall not affect the remaining parts of these bylaws.
