Notes to Financial Statements

Note 1. Summary of significant accounting polices

Basis of accounting

The IBEW General Fund, Special Fund, and Building Fund are prepared on the cash basis of accounting for financial reporting and tax purposes.

Capitalization and depreciation

All expenditures for the purchases of capital assets are recorded as expenditures of the period incurred. These assets are not capitalized. Therefore, no provision is made in these financial statements for depreciation.

Income taxes

The financial statements do not reflect a provision or liability for federal or state income taxes because the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 985 is an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(5) of the Internal Revenue Code. An exempt organization tax return is filed annually.
