ELIGIBILITY

Employees

Active, full-time employees of W R. Grace & Co, or one of its majority-owned subsidiaries, and current directors.

Institutions

- Degree-granting U.S. and Canadian community and junior colleges, four-year colleges and universities, graduate and professional schools and secondary schools.
