STUDENTS OF ABACO AND ELEUTHERA TO BENEFIT FROM PRIME TIME EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

On Friday March 5, 1999 Bob and Judy Yanover of Jupiter Florida announced the establishment of the Prime Time Foundation to benefit one student of Abaco and one from Eleuthera annually in their pursuit of Tertiary Educational opportunities at three universities, namely University of Michigan, Louisiana State University and The University of Florida.

The Yanovers have been cruisers in The Bahamas since 1985 and have named the foundation after their vessel Prime Time. Their purpose is to provide College Scholarships to worthy students from The Bahamas, with special consideration given to the Abacos and Eleuthers.

Mr. Simpson McKinney, of Treasure Cay Abaco, will serve as the local coordinator in conjunction with the District Superintendent of Schools for Abaco Mr. Jackson McIntosh, and Mrs. Cametta Ferguson, Superintendent of schools for the Island of Eleuthera. Their role will be to develop a list of potential candidates which will be presented to the Foundation and the participating Universities for final selection. The awards will be based upon scholastic achievement, character of the individual and recommendations of their teachers. Candidates must successfully pass their S.A.T. and should have been accepted by one of the three schools prior to their application.

The scholarships will include all tuition and room and board. They will be for a period of one year, and will be extended for up to four years based upon the performance of the student.

It is the strong wish of the Foundation, that the successful graduates of this program return home for a minimum period of five(5) years so as to contribute their skills to the improvement of life in The Bahamas.

The scholarships come into affect during the Fall of 1999 and all applications should be returned to the office of the Superintendent of Schools on Abaco and Eleuthers on or before July 19, 1999. The Foundation has the right to reject any or all applications.

Prime Time Foundation Student Criteria

- 1. Potential recipients must be a full time resident of the Abaco Bahamas or Eleuthera Bahamas.
- 2. Recipients must demonstrate financial need.
- 3. Recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress (see criteria for remaining a racipient).
- 4. The scholarship will be awarded to the student with the best academic record who also demonstrates leader-ship qualities and/or a record of community service.
- 5. Upon graduation, the recipiant should agree to return to the Bahamas for a period of 5 years to contribute their skills to the improvement of life in the Bahamas.

Prime Time Foundation Criteria for remaining a recipient of the 4 year Prime Time Scholarship

The prime Time Scolarship may be withdrawn if:

- 1. A GPA of 2.5 with a full acedemic laod is NOT maintained.
- 2. The recipient is placed on disciplinary probation.
- 3. The recipient resigns or drops out of the University.
- 4. The recipient fails to remain enrolled as a full time student.

For each semester the above requirements are met, the recipient will recieve a roundtrip plane ticket home for a visit.
