The David & Francie Horvitz Family Foundation, Inc. (the "Foundation") is pleased to inform The Columbine Foundation ("Grantee") that its Board of Directors has approved a grant of \$50,000.00 to Grantee for the support of the following programs:

- Community development supporting low-income families and individuals, address family values and help children in need
- Art education
- Community support to cancer patients and their families

Because your organization is a private foundation within the meaning of §509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code"), the Foundation has been advised by counsel to enter into this grant agreement with Grantee to help ensure compliance with the Code and to set forth the primary terms of this grant.

- 1. Grantee agrees to use the funds exclusively for its charitable and educational activities as described in Code Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2)(B). Grantee may not use any portion of the grant funds, including any interest earned thereon, for any other purpose.
- 2. Grantee agrees that all of the grant funds it receives shall be used by Grantee for qualifying purposes prior to December 31 of the year following the year of this grant and that Grantee will make all elections necessary to ensure that such use shall be treated as a qualifying distribution made out of corpus for purposes of §4942 of the code.
- 3. Grantee agrees to repay any portion of the grant that is not used for charitable and educational activities as described in Code Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2)(B).
- 4. Grantee agrees to furnish annual written reports to the President of the Foundation describing the manner in which the grant funds are spent, including the names of the recipients and the amount distributed to each recipient, and the progress made to accomplish the grant's purposes. Grantee also agrees to furnish a statement that the grant funds were treated as made out of its corpus for purposes of §4942 of the Code. Grantee agrees to provide the Foundation with a final report upon completion of the grant period.
- 5. Grantee agrees to keep its financial statements and other records in such a manner to adequately account for the use of the grant funds exclusively for the grant's purposes.

- 6. Grantee agrees that it will not use the grant proceeds: (a) to carryout propaganda, or otherwise to attempt to influence legislation; (b) to influence the outcome of any specific election or to carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drive; (c) for grants to individuals for travel or study (unless it received approval from the Service for its scholarship program); (d) for a grant that does not comply with the requirements of Code Section 4945(d)(4); or (e) for any purpose other than the one specified in  $\S170(c)(2)(B)$ of the Code.
- 7. Grantee agrees to supply the Foundation with such other information as the Foundation requests in its sole discretion to establish the proper use of the grant and to permit the Foundation to exercise its responsibility for the supervision of the grant as required by the Code.

I am writing to you in my capacity as Secretary of The Columbine Foundation (the "Grantee") in connection with the grant by the David & Francie Horvitz Family Foundation, Inc (the "Grantor Foundation").

On January 12, 2012 the Grantor Foundation transferred \$50,000.00 to The Columbine Foundation to further its support in the following programs:

- Community development supporting low-income families and individuals, address family values and assist children in need
- Art education
- Community support to cancer patients and their families

This grant was made subject to the expenditure responsibility agreement dated January 9, 2012 between the Grantor Foundation and the Grantee (the "Agreement"). - 2. Used the grant exclusively for the purposes described in Internal Revenue Code §170(c)(2)(B);
- 3. Ensured that none of the grant or any income derived therefrom has been or will be used for any purposes other than those described in Internal Revenue Code §170(c)(2)(B);
- 4. Administered the grant in a separate fund dedicated to one or more of the purposes described in Internal Revenue Code § 170(c)(2)(B);

- 5. Maintained records of receipts and expenditures and has made its books and records available to the Grantor Foundation at reasonable times; and
- 6. Refrained from using any of the grant or the income from the grant:
  - (a) To carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempt, to influence legislation (within the meaning of §4945(d)(1));
  - (b) To influence the outcome of any specific public election, or to carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drive (within the meaning of §4945(d)(2));
  - (c) To make any grant which does not comply with the requirements of §4945(d)(3) or (4); or
  - (d) To undertake any activity for any purpose other than one specified in §170(c)(2)(B).
