PART VI, Line 11b: Each member of the Board of Directors is emailed an electronic copy of the completed IRS-Form 990 in its entirety, along
with its associated Schedules, prior to filing the form.
PART VI, Line 12C: It is the policy of the organization to annually request from all Board Members and Employees a list of any interests that
could give rise to conflicts. This list is monitored by both the Board Chair and the Executive Director. Potential conflicts are also reviewed by
the Board Chair and Executive Director. Any Board members or employees found to have a conflict of interest in a given transaction are
prohibited from participating in deliberations and decisions about that transaction.
PART VI, Lines 15A-B: Compensation of the organization's Executive Director and other key employees is determined on an annual basis. A
review of performance is completed by the employee's immediate supervisor or the Board Chair, a recommendation is made to the Board of
Directors, and compensation of all employees is determined by the Board of Directors through approval of the organizational budget. The
Board of Directors also reviews salary and wage ranges every 2-3 years through reviewing comparative data from other nonprofit
organizations, both statewide and locally.
