AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS OF

MIND SCIENCE FOUNDATION

A NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I.

OFFICES

- 1.1. <u>Principal Office.</u> The principal office of the corporation in the State of Texas shall be located in the city of San Antonio, County of Bexar. The corporation may have such other offices, either within or without the State of Texas, as the Board of Trustees may determine or when the affairs of the corporation may require.
- 1.2. Registered Office and Registered Agent. The corporation shall maintain a registered office in the State of Texas, and a registered agent whose office is identical with such registered office, as required by the Texas Nonprofit Corporation Act. The registered office may be, but need not be, identical with the principal office of the corporation in the State of Texas, and the address of the registered office may be changed from time to time by the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE II.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- 2.1. <u>General Powers.</u> The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by its Board of Trustees. Trustees need not be residents of Texas.
- 2.2. <u>Number and Classes.</u> The number of Trustees of all classes, except Emeritus, shall not be less than seven (7) nor more than twenty-four (24). The number of Trustees may be

fixed from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees adopted at an Annual Meeting thereof. The term of office of an incumbent Trustee shall not be decreased as a result of a reduction in the number of Trustees. There shall be four (4) classes of Trustees as follows: (1) Lifetime Trustees, (2) Institutional Trustees, (3) Elected Trustees, and (4) Emeritus Trustees. Except for the distinctions set forth in these Bylaws, each Trustee shall function in all respects as a member of the Board of Trustees of the corporation. The term "Trustee" or "Trustees" shall refer to any one or more of the four classes of Trustees.

2.3. Election and Term of Office.

- A. <u>Lifetime Trustees:</u> There shall be three Lifetime Trustees, namely William T. Rhame, C. V. Wood and Tom Slick. Each shall serve for the balance of their respective lives or until their resignations have been received by the Secretary of the corporation or until their removal for cause. Upon the death, resignation or removal of a Lifetime Trustee, the number of Lifetime Trustees shall be diminished by one and the number of Elected Trustees shall be increased by one. No other persons shall be named as Lifetime Trustees; therefore, the class of Lifetime Trustees shall be dissolved upon the death, resignation or removal of the last of the Lifetime Trustees.
- B. <u>Institutional Trustees</u>. There shall be three Institutional Trustees appointed by the persons set forth below (hereinafter referred to as the "Appointers") in accordance with 3.04(a) of that certain Trust entitled "Tom Slick Memorial Trust For Mind Science Foundation" dated September 19, 1972 (the "Slick Memorial Trust"):

One Institutional Trustee shall be appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of Southwest Research Institute, a Texas nonprofit corporation.

One Institutional Trustee shall be appointed by the President of Trinity University of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

One Institutional Trustee shall be appointed by the President of The University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas.

In the event of the disqualification, resignation, or failure or refusal to serve of any one of the above three Appointers, the President of St. Mary's University of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas shall serve.

In the event of a further vacancy as a result of the disqualification, resignation, or failure or refusal to serve of an Appointer, the remaining two (2) Appointers shall appoint a third Appointer to serve.

Each Institutional Trustee appointed by an Appointer pursuant to the Slick Memorial Trust shall hold office for the same period as an Elected Trustee. Any vacancy arising from the expiration of the term, resignation, death or removal of an Institutional Trustee shall be filled by the Appointer of that Institutional Trustee. An Appointer may appoint himself or herself to serve as an Institutional Trustee. There shall be no limit on the number of successive terms that an Institutional Trustee may serve. In addition to their rights and obligations as Trustees of the corporation, the Institutional Trustees shall exercise such powers

and conform to such obligations as are set forth in the relevant portions of the Slick Memorial Trust.

- C. <u>Elected Trustees</u>. The maximum number of Elected Trustees shall be determined based on Section 2.2 guidelines and the number of living Lifetime Trustees. Elected Trustees shall be elected by the Board of Trustees and shall serve for a term of three (3) years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified. Terms of elected trustees shall be staggered such that the terms of approximately one-third (1/3) of the trustees shall expire each year. There shall be no limit on the number of successive terms that an Elected Trustee may serve.
- D. Emeritus Trustees. As an honor bestowed from time to time, the Board of Trustees, at its discretion, shall confer the status of Emeritus Trustee upon retiring, or previously retired, board members. There shall be no limit to the number of Emeritus Trustees. Emeritus Trustees shall not have the right to hold office or vote, but may be appointed to committees and serve as Board liaisons. Emeritus Trustees shall receive regular Board communications and shall be invited to attend board meetings but are not required to do so. Emeritus Trustees shall not be counted for the purposes of calculating quorums.
- 2.4. Removal. Any member of the Board of Trustees may be removed for cause by vote of the Board of Trustees, irrespective of the class of Trustees to which that member belongs.
- 2.5. Regular Meetings. A regular Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be held in the City of San Antonio, Texas, at such time and place as may be designated by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees may designate by resolution the time and

place, either within or without the State of Texas, of additional regular meetings of the Board of Trustees without notice other than such resolution.

- 2.6. <u>Special Meetings.</u> Special meetings of the Board of Trustees may be called by or at the request of the Chair of the Board, the President, or at the written request of any two Trustees stating the purpose of such meeting. The person or persons authorized to call a special meeting of the Board may fix any place, within or without the state of Texas, as the place for holding any special meetings of the Board called by them.
- Notice. Notice of any special meeting of the Board of 2.7. Trustees shall be given at least fourteen (14) days previous thereto by written notice delivered personally or sent by mail, email, or telegram to each Trustee at his or her address as shown by the records of the corporation. If mailed, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the United States mail so addressed with postage thereon prepaid. If notice be given by e-mail, such notice shall be deemed to be given upon transmission to the e-mail address last provided by the recipient. If notice be given by telegram, such notice shall be deemed to be delivered when the telegram is delivered to the telegraph company. Any Trustee may waive notice of any meeting. The attendance of a Trustee at any meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except where a Trustee attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the convened. purpose of any regular or special meeting of the Board need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting, unless specifically required by law or by these bylaws.

- 2.8. Quorum. A majority of the total number of Trustees holding office shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of any business except in the case of any matter requiring the approval of the Institutional Trustees as required by the terms of the Slick Memorial Trust document. With regard to the transaction of business which does require such approval by the Institutional Trustees, a quorum shall consist of a majority of the members of the Board of Trustees including the presence of at least two (2) Institutional Trustees.
- 2.9. <u>Manner of Acting</u>. The act of a majority of the Trustees present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall constitute the act of the Board of Trustees, unless the act of a greater number is required by law, by these Bylaws or by the provisions of the Slick Memorial Trust.
- 2.10. Action by Two-Thirds Majority Written Consent of Trustees. Any action by the Board of Trustees may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing setting forth the action so taken is signed by a two-thirds majority of the Trustees. Each written consent shall bear the date of signature of each Trustee who signs the consent. A written consent signed by less than all of the Trustees is not effective to take the action that is the subject of the consent unless, within 60 days after the date of the earliest dated consent delivered to the corporation in the manner required by this Section, a consent or consents signed by the required number of Trustees is delivered to the Chair of the Board or to the Secretary of corporation. shall be by hand, electronic transmission, or certified or registered mail, return receipt requested. Prompt notice of the taking of any action by members without a meeting by less than unanimous written consent shall be given by the Secretary to all members who did not consent in writing to the action. A telegram, telex, cablegram, electronic, or similar

transmission by a member or a photographic, photostatic, facsimile, electronic, or similar reproduction of a writing signed by a member shall be regarded as signed by the member for purposes of this Section.

- 2.11. <u>Vacancies.</u> In the case of an increase in the number of Trustees or a vacancy among the Elected Trustees, the additional Trustee (s) may be elected or vacancy filled by the Board of Trustees at any meeting by vote of a majority of the Trustees in attendance, whether or not a quorum is present. A Trustee elected to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of his or her predecessor. A Trustee elected by reason of an increase in the number of Trustees shall serve for a three year term from the Annual Meeting at which such increase was approved. Any vacancy created by the resignation or removal of an Institutional Trustee shall be filled in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.03(B) hereof. As set forth in Section 2.03(A) hereof, vacancies occurring for any reason among the Lifetime Trustees shall not be filled.
- 2.12. <u>Amendment of Articles of Incorporation</u>. Any amendment to Article II of the Articles of Incorporation shall require the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members of the Board of Trustees.
- 2.13. Participation in Meetings by Telecommunications. Unless otherwise restricted by the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws, members of the Board of Trustees or of any committee thereof may participate in a meeting of such Board or committee by means of conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other and participation in a meeting in such manner shall constitute presence in person at such meeting.

- Action by Electronic Voting. Any action by the Board of 2.14. Trustees may be taken without a meeting if the action is authorized by unanimous e-mail vote. To conduct an e-mail vote, a ballot is sent to the voting Trustees stating exactly what is to be voted on and containing at the beginning a clearly designated place for the member to mark a vote. The subject line (or equivalent) should contain the term "ballot". Voting trustees shall cast their vote by pressing "Reply All". E-mail voting shall be conducted by the Chair. The votes shall be tabulated to produce a report that accompanies the announcement of the result. This report is sent after a deadline (by default, one full business day after ballot distribution). Ballots returned after the deadline, but received before the report is sent are valid votes and must be included in the report. If the e-mail vote results in consensus of at least two-thirds majority but is not unanimous, the Chair shall schedule a conference call or special meeting for further discussion of the matter. Following the discussion, the matter may be resolved by a subsequent e-mail vote, which may carry by two-thirds majority.
- 2.15. <u>Conduct of Meeting.</u> Unless otherwise required by law or these Bylaws, meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be conducted in accordance with Robert's Rules of Order.

ARTICLE III.

STEERING COMMITTEE

3.1. <u>Constitution and Powers.</u> The Board of Trustees shall, by resolution adopted by affirmative vote of a majority of the whole Board of Trustees, appoint a Steering Committee, which shall have and may exercise, during the intervals between the meetings of the Board of Trustees, all the powers and authority of the Board of Trustees in the management of the business, properties and affairs of the Foundation, including authority to take all action provided in the Bylaws to be taken by the

Board of Trustees provided, however, that the foregoing is subject to the applicable provisions of law and shall not be construed as authorizing action by the Steering Committee with respect to any action which pursuant to section 2.02, 2.04, 2.11, 2.12 of Article II, section 3.01 and Section 3.06 of this Article III, Article IV, Section 5.03 and 5.04 of Article V, Sections 7.01 and 7.04 of Article VII and Article XI is required to be taken by vote of the Board of Trustees. The Steering Committee shall consist of such number of Trustees as may from time to time be designated by the Board of Trustees, but shall not be less than three (3) nor more than nine (9) Trustees. far as practicable, the members of the Steering Committee shall be appointed at the Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees in each year, and, unless removed by affirmative vote of a majority of the whole Board of Trustees, shall hold office until the next Annual Meeting and until their respective successors are appointed. All actions taken by the Steering Committee shall be deemed to have been taken under the authority of the Board of Trustees.

- 3.2. <u>Place of Meeting.</u> Meetings of the steering Committee may be held at any place, within or without the state of Texas, at a time designated by the Board of Trustees or the Steering Committee.
- 3.3. <u>Meetings: Notice and Waiver of Notice.</u> Regular meetings of the Steering Committee shall be held at the pleasure of the Board of Trustees or the steering Committee and no notice shall be required for any regular meeting. Special meetings of the Steering Committee shall be called upon request of any two (2) members thereof. Notices of special meetings shall be mailed to each member, addressed to him or her at his

or her residence or usual place of business, not later than two (2) days before the date on which the meeting is to be held, or may be sent to him or her by e-mail, by telegraph, cable or any other form of recorded communication, or be delivered personally or by telephone, on the day of such meeting. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of, any special meeting of the Steering Committee need be specified in any notice or written waiver of notice unless so required by the Bylaws. Notices of any such meeting need not be given to any member of the Steering Committee, however, if waived by him or her.

- Quorum and Manner of Acting. A majority of the members 3.4. of the Steering Committee, but not less than three (3), shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the action of a majority of those present at any meeting at which a quorum is present, shall be the action of the Steering In the absence of a quorum, a majority of the members of the Steering Committee present, or if two or fewer members shall be present, any member of the Steering Committee present, may adjourn any meeting, from time to time, until a quorum is present. No notice of any adjourned meeting need be given other than by announcement at the meeting that is being The provisions of Section 2.15 of Article II with adjourned. respect to participation in a meeting of the Board of Trustees and the provisions of Section 2.10 of Article II with respect to action taken by the Board of Trustees without a meeting shall apply to participation in meetings of and action taken by the Steering Committee.
- 3.5. Records. The Steering Committee shall keep minutes of its actions and proceedings, which shall be submitted at the next

regular meeting of the Board of Trustees unless submitted sooner at a special meeting of the Board of Trustees, and any action taken by the Board of Trustees with respect thereto shall be entered in the minutes of the Board of Trustees.

3.6. <u>Vacancies.</u> Any vacancy among the appointed members of the Steering committee may be filled by affirmative vote of a majority of the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IV. OTHER COMMITTEES

The Board of Trustees may, by a majority vote of the whole Board, designate one or more other standing committees, the membership of which to consist of one {1} or more of the Trustees of the Foundation. Such standing committees shall have and may exercise all the powers of the Board of Trustees in the management of the business and affairs of the Foundation to the extent set forth in the resolutions authorizing the formation thereof. Such committee, or committees, shall report their proceedings and actions to the Board of Trustees when required.

ARTICLE V. OFFICERS

5.1. Officers. The officers of the Foundation shall consist of a Chair of the Board, one or more Vice Chairs (the number thereof to be determined by the Board of Trustees), a Secretary, a Treasurer and such other officers as may be elected in accordance with the provisions of this Article. The Board of Trustees may elect or appoint such other officers, including one or more Assistant Secretaries and one or more Assistant Treasurers, as it shall deem desirable, such officers to have

the authority and perform the duties prescribed by the Board of Trustees. Any two or more offices may be held by the same person, except the offices of Chair of the Board and secretary.

- 5.2. <u>Election and Term of Office</u>. The officers of the Foundation shall be elected annually by the Board of Trustees at the regular annual meeting of the Board of Trustees. If the election of officers is not held at such meeting, such election shall be held as soon thereafter as practicable. New offices may be created and filled at any meeting of the Board of Trustees. Each officer shall hold office until his or her successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified.
- 5.3. Removal. Any officer elected or appointed by the Board of Trustees may be removed by the Board of Trustees whenever in its judgment the best interests of the Foundation would be served thereby, but such removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the officer so removed.
- 5.4. <u>Vacancies.</u> A vacancy in the office because of death, resignation, disqualification or otherwise, may be filled by the Board of Trustees for the unexpired portion of the term.
- 5.5. Chair of the Board. The Chair of the Board shall be the chief executive officer of the Foundation and shall in general supervise all of the business and affairs of the Foundation. He or she shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Trustees, and in general he or she shall perform all duties incident to the office of Chairman and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Trustees from time to time. The Chair, with appropriate other Officers and Trustees, shall recruit and hire the Chief Operating Officer of the Foundation.

- 5.6. <u>Vice Chairs</u>. The Vice Chair (or in the event there be more than one Vice Chair, the Vice Chairs) shall perform such duties and shall have such powers as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the Chair of the Board of Trustees.
- Treasurer. If required by the Board of Trustees, the Treasurer shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of his or her duties in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the Board of Trustees shall determine. He or she shall have charge and custody of and be responsible for all funds and securities of the corporation; receive and give receipts for moneys due and payable to the corporation from any source whatsoever, and deposit all such moneys in the name of the corporation in such banks, trust companies, or other depositories as shall be selected in accordance with these bylaws; and in general perform all the duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the Chair or by the Board of Trustees.
- Secretary. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Trustees in one or more books provided for that purpose; give all notices in accordance with the provisions of these bylaws or as required by law; be custodian of the corporate records; keep a register of the post office address of each member which shall be furnished to the Secretary by each member; and, in general, perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the Chair or by the Board of Trustees.
- 5.9. <u>Assistant Treasurers and Assistant Secretaries</u>. If required by the Board of Trustees, the Assistant Treasurers shall give bonds for the faithful discharge of their duties in

such sums and with such sureties as the Board of Trustees shall determine. The Assistant Treasurers and Assistant Secretaries in general shall perform such duties as shall be assigned to them by the Treasurer or the Secretary or by the Chair or the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE VI.

INDEMNITY

- Indemnification. The Foundation shall indemnify its Trustees and officers from and against any and all liabilities, costs, and expenses incurred by them in such capacities to the fullest extent permitted by the Business Organizations Code, as presently in effect and as may be hereafter amended, and shall have the power to purchase and maintain liability insurance coverage for those persons or make and maintain other arrangements on such persons' behalf as, and to the fullest extent, permitted by such Act, as presently in effect and as may be hereafter amended.
- 6.2. Indemnification Not Exclusive. The rights of indemnification and reimbursement provided for in Section 6.1 of this Article VI shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which any such Trustee or officer may be entitled under the Articles of Incorporation, or as a matter of law or otherwise.

ARTICLE VII.

CONTRACTS, CHECKS, DEPOSITS, AND FUNDS

7.1. <u>Contracts.</u> The Board of Trustees may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents of the corporation, in addition to the officers so authorized by these bylaws, to enter

into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the corporation. Such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

- 7.2. Checks and Drafts. All checks, drafts, or orders for the payment of money, notes, or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the corporation shall be signed by such officer or officers, agent or agents of the corporation, and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board of Trustees.
- 7.3. <u>Deposits.</u> All funds of the corporation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the corporation in such banks, trust companies, or other depositories as the Board of Trustees may select.
- 7.4. <u>Gifts.</u> The Board of Trustees may accept on behalf of the corporation any contribution, gift, bequest, or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the corporation. The Foundation may retain or dispose of any such gift as deemed appropriate by the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE VIII. BOOKS AND RECORDS

The corporation shall keep correct and complete books and records of account and shall also keep minutes of the proceedings of Board of Trustees and committees having any of the authority of the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IX.

FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the corporation shall begin on the first day of January and end on the last day in December in each year.

ARTICLE X.

WAIVER OF NOTICE

Whenever any notice is required to be given under the provisions of the Texas Nonprofit Corporation Act or under the provisions of the articles of incorporation or the bylaws of the corporation, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

ARTICLE XI.

AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

These bylaws may be altered, amended, or repealed and new bylaws may be adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the full Board of Trustees, if at least five days' written notice is given of an intention to alter, amend, or repeal these bylaws or to adopt new bylaws at such meeting.

These bylaws were approved and adopted by the Board of Trustees at a special meeting duly called, held and convened on the 2^{nd} day of May, 2013.

MANAGEMENT BELIEVES THAT ALL ASSETS OWNED BY THE FOUNDATION, INCLUDING CASH, ARE REQUIRED TO BE USED FOR THE FOUNDATION'S CURRENT OPERATION IN ORDER TO PAY ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES AND OTHER NORMAL EXPENDITURES DIRECTLY RELATED TO THE FOUNDATION'S CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES. MANAGEMENT BELIEVES THAT HISTORICAL CASH FLOW STATISTICS SUPPORT THIS CONCLUSION.
