## **Grant Application Guidelines**

The Lola Wright Foundation limits its giving to 501(c) (3) non-profit organizations located in Texas and operating primarily within a 50-mile radius of Austin, Texas. It is the policy of the board of directors of the Foundation to make no grants to individuals or to organizations for the purpose of providing funds for day-to-day operating costs or expenses. Also, an organization receiving a grant from the Foundation may not apply for another grant for at least twelve (12) months.

The Lola Wright Foundation Board meets twice a year, usually in May and November, to consider grant requests. Completed grant requests must be received no later than February 28<sup>th</sup> (for May meeting) or August 31<sup>st</sup> (for November meeting). An item postmarked February 28<sup>th</sup> or August 31<sup>st</sup>, but received by us at a later date, does not constitute delivery to us by the deadline date. If the due date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or Holiday, then the deadline date shall be the last working day prior to the due date. Late applications will not be reviewed or retained.

Proposals may be mailed or delivered. No proposals will be accepted by e-mail or fax. If you find that by using U.S. Mail or other carriers, you cannot have your grant application in our hands by the deadline date of February 28<sup>th</sup> or August 31<sup>st</sup>, you may hand-deliver the application between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., on any Monday through Friday (exclusive of holidays), prior to the due date. (See the Proposal Guidelines for delivery directions.)

To facilitate the grant application review process, the **Proposal Guidelines** must be followed, and a **Proposal Fact Sheet** must be completed by all applicants requesting funds from the Lola Wright Foundation. Items in the **Proposal Guidelines** and **Proposal Fact Sheet** must be included in each application as listed. **Proposals submitted without the requested information will not be considered.** 

Please note: under item N of the Proposal Guidelines, only one copy of the materials requested should be provided.

- A. Cover letter: (one page maximum, not counted in the 6-page limit)
- B. Table of Contents: (one-page maximum, not counted in the 6-page limit)
- C. Proposal Fact Sheet: (two-page maximum, not counted in the 6-page limit)

NOTE: Items D through L must not exceed six (6) pages. Please number each page.

- D. Project Name: The name of the project.
- E. Project Director: Please provide all relevant contact information.
- F. Project Description: Describe the project, including a summary of the critical issues or opportunities it will address, its benefits to the community, and the changes or results the project will attain.
- G. Project Cost: State the total cost of the project, the specific dollar amount requested from the Foundation, and the date payment is needed. As an attachment under item M, list all entities asked to give financial support to the proposed project. Please include their responses to date and dollar amounts committed. Also, include plans to support the project after the grant period.

If your request includes funds for construction of a new building, or improvements, renovation or repairs to an existing structure, please indicate whether you own the land and improvements or lease them. If the property is leased, please attach one copy of your current lease **under item N**.
