The buildings are on United States Department of Agriculture/US Forest Service land in the Angeles National Forest. The estimated value is based on replacement cost less depreciation. The transaction was made under the approval of the USDA/USFS.

In response to Part II, Balance Sheets, Line 24

Redbird was given a 1990 Chevrolet Suburban in running condition. Kelley Blue Book value for a 1992 model is \$1,474.00 in like condition. Kelley Blue Book values only span twenty years of age on any vehicle, so basing the estimated value on the 1992 model was as close as we are able to verify the vehicle's worth.
