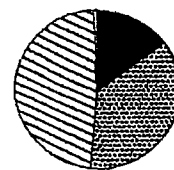

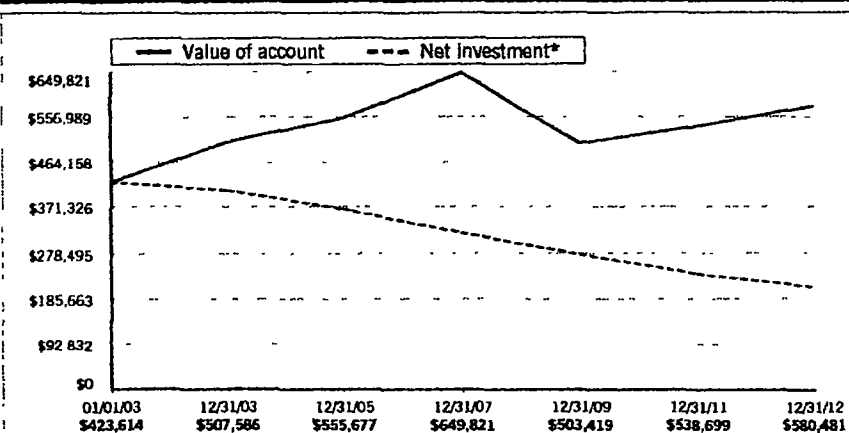

### Cost basis

Effective January 1, 2012, the IRS requires American Funds to report cost basis information to both investors and the IRS on the sale or exchange of mutual fund shares acquired on or after January 1, 2012, called "covered" shares. The IRS requirements apply only to taxable accounts. Tax-favored accounts, including 529 and retirement accounts, are not included in the requirements.

American Funds uses Average Cost as the default cost basis method for covered shares unless you have selected another method for your account.
