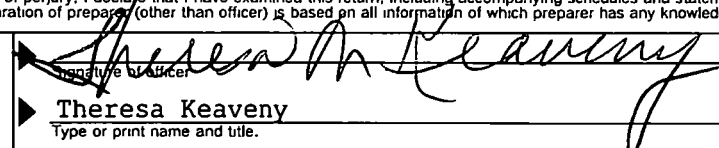

Voter Education and Conservation Policy Campaign: Montana Conservation Voters conducted public policy advocacy and public education work directed at the Montana Congressional delegation to support the ability of the Environmental Protection Agency to enforce the Clean Air Act, resulting in a wide range of letters to the editor, petitions, guest commentaries and sign-ons. Two MCV members and three MCV staff took part in a Washington, DC Lobby Day in early June with the League of Conservation Voters and spoke with members of Montana's Congressional delegation and the White House regarding the Clean Air Act and the Safe Chemicals Act. MCV conducted outreach meetings with church and public health leaders to obtain support for the Safe Chemicals Act, held a May, 2012 "Stroller Brigade" and thanked Montana's Senators for their sponsorship of the measure, announced in late July. MCV also opposed bills to limit access to public lands introduced by Congressman Dennis Rehberg (Border bill) and provided information on its impacts to voters.

At the state level, MCV convened the Conservation Working Group, a coalition of 12 organizations working on state-level policy, to prepare its 2013 legislative campaign. Associated briefing materials were developed and distributed. MCV convened 8 legislative meetings around Montana between November 15th and December 31, 2012, attended by approximately 170 people.

MCV utilized results of public opinion research to launch an outreach campaign to low and moderate income women, hunting and fishing license holders and infrequent voters to discuss public lands, clean water. Informational materials were prepared

as part of the roll out of the poll to brief state legislators, local officials and allies, as well as MCV chapter and Board leaders.

As part of its non-partisan civic engagement work, MCV met with county election officials in Yellowstone, Gallatin, Park, Missoula, Flathead and Cascade counties to identify election barriers and polling place challenges, to reduce long lines and encourage voting. MCV also recommended better information on county websites regarding absentee balloting and voter registration. Additionally, MCV and other allies met with the Montana Secretary of State to discuss compliance with the national motor voter law.

Ballot measure work in 2012 included support of I-166, which called on Montana's public officials to ban corporate contributions and spending in elections; and a Bozeman parks and trails bond. Both passed on the November, 2012 ballot.

MCV also prepared a non-partisan questionnaire and mailed it to state legislative, statewide, public service commission and land board candidates, and distributed the results to its chapter and organizational leaders. MCV provided leadership training for its members and allies on voter communication and

Bozeman, Livingston, Helena, Great Falls, Whitefish, Kalispell, Billings and Columbia Falls, garnering approximately 17,420 new associate members. Additional outreach was done at presentations and appearances at "conservation roundtables" in Great Falls, the Flathead, Missoula and Billings. These are gatherings of conservation allies who come together to monthly to share information on environmental and conservation issues.

MCV's Yellowstone County chapter held a program in July, 2012 featuring a speaker on ballot measures. MCV's Gallatin-Park County chapter held an annual meeting and Congressional candidate forum in February, 2012 and a summer picnic featuring state legislative speakers. MCV chapters in the Flathead and Missoula held September annual meetings featuring state legislative speakers. All chapters hosted pre-legislative meetings in December.
