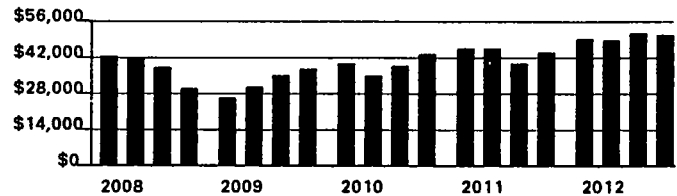

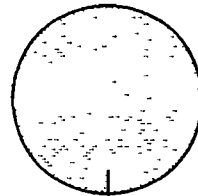


Annualized total portfolio return 15.75%
