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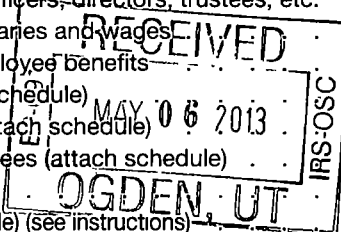

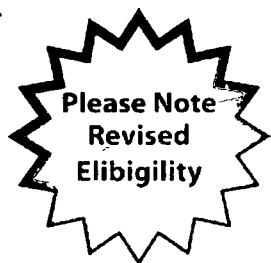

Current recipients need to submit the renewal form for the continuance of the scholarship. A current "official" transcript from the Registrar must accompany the renewal form.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of funds available and the applicant's eligibility.
