	Sky Island Alliance protects the health and integrity of ecosystems of the Sky Island region, and works to ensure resilience of the
	landscape in the face of a changing climate. Sky Island Alliance monitors land-use activities on public lands, acting as a watch-dog to
	protect wildlife habitat, and clean air and water. SIA advocates for conservation-based management and protection of the region's
	native plant and animal species, their habitat, and watersheds through engagement in public processes and grassroots organizing.
	Sky Island Alliances's work includes monitoring land-use activities which present the biggest threats to watershed health, including
	large-scale energy transmission lines and other lineal features that negatively influence watershed processes and conditions in a
	manner similar to roads, as well as mining activities proposed for some of the region's key watersheds that provide municipal water
	supplies to urban and rural communities. The proposed mining activities in the Patagonia and Santa Rita Mountains will have
	especially significant impacts on the watershed health in an area that serves as a critical wildlife corridor.

	SIA engaged in a variety of landscape restoration projects throughout the Sky Island Region during the past year with a focus on
	building ecological resilience in vulnerable riparian and aquatic ecosystems. Cumulatively, these projects resulted in 17 volunteer
	field weekends that engaged 123 volunteers and resulted in 2,136 hours of volunteer effort. Our efforts included protecting water
	resources both at the watershed level and at specific locations of management interest and high ecological value.
	The goals of increasing the volume of water available on the landscape and improving the quality of riparian and aquatic habitats are
	consistent in each of SIA's 2012 restoration projects. SIA has continued to focus on low-tech strategies including construction of
	water-slowing structures to increase water infiltration, thereby keeping reducing soil erosion. Other effective tactics include
	installation of livestock-exclusion fencing in riparian areas and manipulation of stream channel morphology to encourage the creation
	of ponds. Our approach, working closely with volunteers, landowners and resource management professionals during planning and

	records to the Madrean Archipelago Biodiversity database, a publicly accessible biological database representing the most
	dataset for biodiversity in the Sky Island region. Thanks to cooperation from universities, agencies, herbariums and other groups in
	the region, we have grown this database to hold an estimated 100,000 records gathered from scientific field expeditions, collections
	and individual documentations including photo vouchers. SIA has trained over 100 students and volunteers on the use of the MABA
	database to access valuable information for educational and conservation purposes.
