The original form 990 filed failed to report \$2,376 of the contributions received (line 8), -\$2,988 of grants paid (line 13), and \$22,261 of expenses paid (line 17). Therefore, the original fund balance (line 22) was overstated by this \$16,897 difference. The original bank balance was also overstated by the same amount.

Out of the total program expenses not previously reported, \$13,082 was related to inpatient services (part III 4a), \$8,721 was related to outpatient services (part III 4b). The prior school fund expenses were overstated by \$2,988 and the management & general expenses were increased by \$458. The amended return correctly reports these corresponding changes.
