	The Foundation is committed to supporting the efforts of Swedish Health Services. To that end, the Foundation awards grants to Swedish to fund vital programs and services, new medical treatments and technology, charity care and other programs that provide access to the underserved, nursing clinics, patient transportation, needed facilities maintenance and upgrades and a variety of related community health programs.

	The Ben & Catherine Ivy Center for Advanced Brain Tumor Treatment (the Ivy Center) at Swedish Medical Center's Neuroscience Institute was founded in 2008 to create a world-class treatment and research facility whose primary focus would be to find new treatments - and ultimately a cure - for brain cancer. Since its establishment, the Ivy Center has led the expansion drive of major research projects and expanded treatment options for patients living with brain cancer in the Pacific Northwest and throughout the world. Much of this progress, including the screening of more than 2,000 drugs to identify possible future brain cancer treatments, and the initial development stages of a potential brain cancer vaccine, has been made possible by more than \$13 million raised for the program to date

	Swedish has become a national leader in treating patients with multiple sclerosis (MS) and in conducting a broad range of MS-related clinical research studies. The MS Center at the Swedish Neuroscience Institute is also the primary referral center for patients in the Puget Sound region seeking specialty MS care. The Center is projected to see over 12,000 patients in 2013. To address and prepare for future growth, the Center recently underwent a major expansion. In April 2012, Swedish opened a new 11,700 square-foot space on the Swedish/Cherry Hill campus that is one of the largest and most comprehensive MS centers in the United States. The expansion consolidated state-of-the-art clinical care, research studies, and patient and family education activities in a facility designed to promote the well-being of MS patients and to advance the standard of care for MS. More than \$4 million in community support has been raised to date to support the MS Center's physical expansion, and the growth in comprehensive programming at the Center since 2010.

	In 2012, the Swedish Medical Center Foundation was able to utilize important gifts from the community to support a wide-variety of cardiovascular related programs, including * The construction of a new Hybrid Operating Room* Research funding through our Rising Stars Research Fund* Launching our TAVR (Trans Aortic Valve Replacement) program The Hybrid Operating Room combines state-of-the-art surgical equipment with advanced imaging equipment typically found in a cardiac cath lab such as an angiography, CT scans and MRI. It allows for minimally invasive procedures, high risk situations and care providers to collaborate all in one space. The Rising Stars program provides support to selected physicians and clinicians to enable them to take time away from their clinical practices to pursue investigational or educational interests that are important to their professional development. We have used funds to purchase equipment, develop technologies and support services needed for innovative research activities that have the potential both to advance medical science and to provide better treatment options for cardiovascular patients at the Swedish Heart and Vascular Institute. TAVR was launched at Swedish to assist patients who are too vulnerable for open heart surgery and provide lifesaving treatments to those who otherwise would not have treatment options. This has been made possible by a catheter-based system that is less invasive and results in shorter procedure time and hospital stay.
