	counselors' effectiveness in helping individuals overcome a gambling addiction. The program also offers certification and
	training to individuals who are responsible for furnishing treatment services to those who have been identified as having a
	gambling addiction.

	Education/Outreach/Youth Services:
	Public education focuses on helping individuals and the community at large to be able to identify gambling addictions. This is
	accomplished by making problem gambling information and resources available to the general public. The information is
	available via the Council's website in electronic download as well as in paper and video form. The Youth Services program is
	designed to caution youth about problem gambling. The Council operates a Speaker's Bureau to conduct public awareness
	presentations throughout the state. The Bureau is available to most school districts within Washington State (and is also
	available to present at other venues). Youth Services also includes a music-based conference, New Directions, to help youth
	become aware of the potential negative effects of gambling addictions and to also become aware of alternate healthy choices
	in entertainment and recreational activities.

	Treatment/Therapeutic Justice:
	The Treatment and Therapeutic Justice program includes both residential and outpatient treatment services for problem

	provider manual with tools and forms for service providers to deliver services to problem gamblers.
