	Habitat Protection & Restoration: Columbia Riverkeeper ("Riverkeeper") works to protect and restore critical fish and wildlife habitat.
	Riverkeeper promotes a diverse coalition of people working to restore a Columbia River where people can safely catch fish and child-
	ren can play in the water without fear of sickness. To achieve this, we integrate community organizing, enforcement of environmental
	laws, and hands-on citizen action.
	In 2012, Riverkeeper worked to protect estuarine wetlands from proposed Liquefied Natural Gas terminals and pipelines that threaten-
	ed to degrade key salmon habitat, as well as family farms and forestland. Riverkeeper worked with over 100 farmers, fishermen, and
	landowners, as well as over ten conservation groups to form a strong coalition to protect Oregon and Washington resources.
	Riverkeeper also submitted extensive public records requests and educated the public about proposed coal export terminals that
	threaten Columbia River communities. Coal companies propose to strip mine coal in Wyoming and Montana and ship it via trains
	along the Columbia River Gorge to ports on the lower Columbia. Coal export infrastructure and ships would degrade our water
	quality and salmon habitat. If built, dozens of coal trains per day would impact Pacific Northwest communities. Coal contains toxic
	pollutants and when burned is a major contributor to harmful climate change. Riverkeeper and allies worked (continued in Sch. O)

	River Communities Project: Riverkeeper unites and trains citizen volunteers across hundreds of miles to watchdog stretches of the
	Columbia and collect water quality data. The River Communities Project provides tools for local citizens to monitor water quality
	and habitat health in their communities along the Columbia River and its tributaries. This Project is one of the largest and most
	comprehensive citizen water quality monitoring program in the Pacific Northwest, serving 118 volunteers at 73 sites. Our program
	cultivates stewardship by providing a hands-on activity that creates tangible river benefits. After learning about and caring for a river
	stretch in their community, our volunteers become active local voices working to better their waterways and their communities.
	Riverkeeper utilized the River Communities Project to advocate for more protective water quality standards, less toxic pollution in
	salmon, and clean and healthy swimming and recreational areas. The Project includes
	1. Adopt-A-River: Riverkeeper recruits volunteers to adopt a section of the Columbia or a local tributary, and work to protect and re-
	store it. Volunteers receive training from Riverkeeper staff in how to identify plants, wildlife, water quality, and threats to their
	section. Volunteers regularly report on their adopted section and identify necessary restoration, which Riverkeeper then implements.
	In addition, Riverkeeper regularly makes presentations in schools in Washington & Oregon, serving hundreds of (continued in Sch O)

	Reducing Toxic Pollution: Riverkeeper works to reduce the threat of toxic pollution in the Columbia River. Our goal is to restore the
	public trust rights so people can catch and eat fish and swim with their families in the Columbia River without fear of toxic pollution.
	Riverkeeper uses science-based advocacy, grass roots organizing, and legal enforcement of environmental laws to work toward this
	goal. In 2012, the Washington Department of Ecology proposed to issue new water quality criteria for toxic pollution. Riverkeeper
	advocated for strong protections for aquatic life and people who eat fish We helped organize a coalition and communicated with
	tribal allies. Similar to our success in obtaining better water quality standards in Oregon, Riverkeeper educated the public on the
	importance of new water quality standards by holding public outreach events, using social media, developing easy-to-understand fact
	sheets, and promoting the issue to local newspaper and television. Riverkeeper met with Department of Ecology staff, tribal
	representatives, and key stakeholders, and provided technical comments on how the make the water quality standards more pro-
	tective of human health.
	Riverkeeper also participated in and presented at EPA's Columbia River Toxics Reduction Workgroup. In this group of mostly state

In 2012, Riverkeeper trained volunteers to conduct samplin for water clarity, pH, temperature, dissolved oxygen, and conductivity (to test for heavy metals presence) twice per month during sampling season at dozens of strategic locations along the Columbia River. We also test for fecal coliform swimming areas and some tributaries The project is coordinated with the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, which recognizes Riverkeeper's data as the highest quality assurance ranking available. This project gives citizens a hands-on way to provide tangible benefits to water quality. Riverkeeper is dedicated to reaching beyond the typical environmental-group volunteer, as demonstrated by our work with rural, minority, and Native American communities. In 2012, Riverkeeper conducted Adopt-A-River and Water Quality Monitor trainings in the following Columbia River Basin cities: Cathlamet, WA; Longview, WA; Portland, OR; and Gresham, OR. These events served over 50 people by training new volunteers and refreshing returning volunteers. Riverkeeper's water quality monitoring program provides Oregon and Washington state agencies with valuable water quality data. Riverkeeper also uses the data to educate decision makers on the water quality problems facing the Columbia River Basin. The information is also used a part of Riverkeeper's efforts to reduce pollution and protect and restore habitat in the basin. Riverkeeper submitted the water quality data to the Washington Department of Ecology and the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, which utilizes the data to inform toxics reduction and cleanup decisionmaking. For example, Riverkeeper submitted data that shows that some river segments are violating water quality standards, which requires the state agencies to take action to prevent new pollution and reduce existing pollution FORM 990, PART II, Section 4c continued: Riverkeeper also utilized public pressure, grassroots organizing, and technical assessment of cleanup plans to advocate for the thorough cleanup of the Hanford Nuclear Site, which is the most contaminated place in the western hemisphere. Riverkeeper has resisted efforts by the U.S. Department of Energy to import new waste to Hanford. In 2012, Riverkeeper produced several action alerts and issue briefings on technical issues and upcoming decisions. Riverkeeper also organized citizen attendance and testimony at multiple hearings regarding important Hanford clean-up decisions, including decisions on how to clean up leaking storage tanks containing high-level nuclear waste. We also led two paddle trips on the Hanford Reach of the Columbia River to give members a firsthand account of the nuclear site. In late 2012, Riverkeeper hired a Hanford Coordinator to implement our work to reduce the impacts of
