This accomplishment was achieved with the help of 86 sponsors and 360 golfers. Program services by expense incurred include: Tournament expenses (\$51,909), the Pairings Party expenses (\$15,071), and Prizes/Auction expenses (\$7,163).

Fluor Cares team in Sugar Land, TX coordinates an annual golf tournament with Fluor Executives, Clients and Vendors which raised funds for four (4) non-profit organizations: 1) Blessed Be Hope for Three Inc.; 2) Casa de Esperanza de los Ninos, Inc.; 3) The Arc of Fort Bend; and 4) The Children's Assessment Center, that were selected through an application process to support their programs and services. The donations from GFGH will use to provide counseling and therapy for sexually abused children, foster care for abused and neglected children, services and therapies for children suffering from autism and opportunities for people with disabilities to be active participants in society.

Building Futures is an annual community outreach project in which Fluor Cares teams provided backpacks filled with school supplies to schools and youth organizations benefiting children. Fluor employees donated school supplies and money to fill 1,250 backpacks and provide classroom supplies for the Boys & Girls Clubs of Capistrano Valley, Santa Ana, Long Beach. In addition classroom supplies were donated to Betsy Ross School, Russell Elementary School and Los Amigos High School. 200 backpacks and bulk school supplies were donated to Dallas and Irving, TX public schools. A total of 425 children were impacted by the contributions made in the Dallas area. 1,012 backpacks filled with school supplies were distributed to children in grades K - 5th in Greenville, SC. Over 1,000 backpacks were distributed to Hunter's Glen and Deaf Smith Elementary Schools in the Houston, TX area.
