Initial Return of Former Public Charity

The Foundation was formed on December 29, 2008 as a 501(c)(3) public charity. At the time of its formation, the Foundation planned to solicit contributions primarily from Infosys Limited and its directors, officers and employees. The Foundation intended to communicate with such persons by email and through Internet web site postings. Given that Infosys Limited has over 11,000 employees working in 43 states, the Foundation reasonably expected to receive a substantial portion of its contributions from individual employees of Infosys Limited and therefore reasonably expected to meet the public support test. The Foundation therefore requested public charity status in its Form 1023 exemption application and was granted such status by the IRS.

Since its inception and through the year ended March 31, 2013, the Foundation only received contributions from Infosys Limited, due to the fact that it had been unable to begin any significant solicitation program with the employees of Infosys Limited. During the fiscal year ended March 31, 2013, the Foundation determined that it did not expect to begin any significant solicitation program in the foreseeable future, and therefore determined that it should more properly be classified as a private foundation beginning with that year.

The Foundation has therefore filed a Form 990-PF for its fiscal year ended March 31, 2013.
