Furthermore, the organization must determine whether they have any unrelated business income, which may be subject to US Federal Income Tax. The Organization analyzed its filing positions in the federal and state jurisdictions where it is required to file income tax returns, as well as all open tax years in these jurisdictions. The Organization has also elected to retain its existing accounting policy with respect to the treatment of interest and penalties attributable to income taxes, and continues to reflect any charges for such, to the extent they arise, as a component of its management and general expenses. The continued application of ASC Topic 740 has had no significant impact on the OrganizationOs consolidated financial statements. The Organization has evaluated the provisions of ASC Topic 740 for years 2008 through 2012, the years which remain subject to examination by major tax jurisdictions as of March 31,2013. The Organization concludes that there are no significant uncertain tax positions requiring recognition in the consolidated financial statements. The Organization does not expect the total amount of unrecognized tax benefits (UTB) (e.g. tax deductions, exclusions, or credits claimed or expected to be claimed) to significantly change in the next twelve months. The Organization does not have any amounts accrued for interest and/or
