With a vision to reach ONE BILLION SOULS for the Kingdom, ACTT produces and transmits evangelistic Christian programming worldwide, broadcasting from Jerusalem to the ends of the earth. The GOD Channel is currently broadcast around the world 24-hours-a-day, reaching 190 million homes - a figure which translates into 600 million people in more than 200 nations and territories - who can watch the GOD Channel by a click of their remote control. The powerful free-to-air satellite signal is also pulled down and redistributed by various cable networks in India, Nepal, Hong Kong, Nigeria, Cameroon, the UK, Europe and various Nordic countries. The GOD Channel signal is also rebroadcast through a number of terrestrial transmitters, for example in Africa, where the ministry presently has four transmitters in Kenya, covering a population of 13 million people. When the GOD Channel is not available through other means, viewers can watch via web streaming. Everyday we receive feedback from viewers in countries from South America to the Middle East who are watching through the Internet. Our broadcasting now covers four-fifths of the earth's surface, 24-hours-a-day, which puts us well on our way to reaching our goal of ONE BILLION SOULS for the Kingdom.
