Electing out of Bonus Depreciation Allowance for All Eligible Depreciable Property

The taxpayer elects out of first-year bonus depreciation allowance under IRC Section 168(k) for all eligible asset classes of depreciable property acquired after December 31, 2007. This election applies to all eligible depreciable property placed in service during the tax year.

We completed our Riverbank Restoration work and in Lion's Park which extended the WRLT's Hailey Greenway. This area was once a city dump and the Wood River Land Trust in cooperation with local government entities and the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality removed 1,200 tons of dump material in 2008.

Project development and outreach continued for the River Restoration at Sunpeak and the Hulen Meadows Pond. The project's goal is riparian and river area restoration and improvement of public recreational opportunities. In 2010 surveying and floodplain analysis was conducted and we completed the study for the hydrological and restoration work, flood plain analysis, project analysis, mapping, topographic assessments, initial consultant reviews, approval by the City of Ketchum and legal consultation for stream restoration, flood plain analysis and project analysis which needed to be completed prior to the on-the-ground implementation of any restoration work. Cuurently an Environmental Assessment (EA) of the project was conducted and is in the review process. This EA and its review was funded in part by the Wood River Land Trust.

The Wood River Land Trust continued its work to reestablish enhanced year-round stream flow in the Big Wood River channel below Magic Reservoir dam. The project's work has primarily consisted of the collaboration with the Big Wood Canal company to consider the release of water year-round in order to reestablish the fishery and riparian area as close to its historical condition as is possible. Outside of the spring/summer irrigation season, no water is released from the dam and the river becomes a trickle as it is comprised solely of water from various low flow springs. In autumn and winter the shutting off of the water can result in a substantial fish kill when stranded fish die from lack of oxygen or water. This manipulated and inconsistent stream flow also disrupts wildlife and normal plant life cycles.

Staff organized volunteer work days at riparian/floodplain areas at Boxcar Bend. Howard Preserve, Croy Creek Wetland and Draper Wood River preserves on the Big Wood River, with emphasis on control of noxious weeds.

Land Stewardship:

Staff monitored all thirty-seven (37) Wood River Land Trust conservation easements encompassing 10,175.59 acres to ensure compliance with individual easement restrictions/language and to note any changes in the property. All monitoring data, such as photo points, were reported and entered into the permanent record.

In December of 2012 the WRLT also acquired our thirty-eighth (38) easement - Champagne Creek. This donated easement is on 191.01 acres of productive farm land located in Butte County, Idaho.

Fee simple lands were also monitored. These Land Trust preserves are maintained in their natural state and/or restored to a healthy landscape. Stewardship staff addresses such ongoing problems as noxious weeds, trash, vehicle incursions, and damaged trails.

Land Acquisition/Protection:

The Wood River Land Trust closed on its sale of the Timbered Dome property to a conservation-minded rancher. We helped this rancher apply for a Grasslands Reserve Program easement which resulted in the property becoming the #1 rated property in the region to be permanently protected under the Grasslands Reserve Program. The Grassland Reserve Program (GRP) is a voluntary conservation program that emphasizes support for working grazing operations, enhancement of plant and animal biodiversity, and protection of grassland under threat of conversion to other uses. Participants voluntarily limit future development and crop cultivation uses of the land while retaining the right to conduct common grazing practices and operations related to the production of forage and seeding. GRP protected acreage are subject to certain restrictions during nesting seasons of Greater Sage-Grouse that are in significant decline and/or are proposed for protection under Federal or State law. A grazing management plan is required for participants. Sagebrush and grasses are the predominant vegetation on the 1,609-acre property. The ranch is bordered by BLM and private lands and is a critical migratory corridor for clk, deer and antelope and hosts a wintering herd of approximately 250 clk and mule deer. Timbered Dome provides year-round habitat for elk, chukar, raptors, pygmy rabbit, mule deer, and migratory songbirds. Most important are the resident Sage Grouse and their leks on and near the property which needed added protection.

For over eight (8) years the WRLT worked on the transferring of two of our fee simple properties, Square Lake and Sheep Bridge, to the Bureau of Land Management. These two properties were acquired through a bargain sale at the height of the real estate bubble. Over the timespan of this transaction the real estate bubble burst and property values plummeted with raw land being bit the hardest. Although this year's 990 shows an investment income loss of \$1.1 million the WRLT's out-of-pocket loss was just over \$200K due to our acquisition of the properties through a bargain sale. The Square Lake and Sheep Bridge properties continue to have their conservation values protected with the new ownership and the WRLT has \$900,000 from the sale of the properties that it can now reinvest to acquire and protect more acreage in and around the Wood River Valley.

Through our staff's collaborative work with the Pioneer's Alliance we were able to aid other ranchers and property owners to qualify to protect their properties under the Grasslands Reserve Program.

The Wood River Land Trust acquired 1.708 acres, called the Harris property, in the City of Bellevue of which 1.37 acres is located adjacent to the Howard Preserve in the Big Wood River riparian area. This 1.37 acres has been opened to public access and has expanded the public's enjoyment of the area while eliminating trespassing issues.
