CRITERIA AND GUIDELINES FOR NEW APPLICANTS ATTENDING COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY (UNDERGRADUATES) ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-2013

- 1. Individuals eligible for scholarships must be legal residents within the geographic area of Laredo, and/or Webb County and, at the discretion of the Trust Committee, a County that is contiguous to Webb County. A legal resident, for purposes of this application, is defined as a <u>U.S. citizen or Resident Alien</u> who is domiciled and resides in Laredo or Webb County and who has expressed an intent to remain domiciled in Webb County. Applicant must have resided within Laredo or Webb County for a minimum of three (3) years and, in addition, must provide a copy of a current utility bill showing their residential address within the County.
- 2. Family adjusted gross income *cannot exceed* \$85,000 a year. The income requirement must be met every year.
- 3. Student must maintain a cumulative grade point average of <u>2.75</u> and pass <u>12</u> semester hours (excluding CLEP earned hours) otherwise, further funding of the scholarship may be denied. Those students planning to attend a technical or vocational school will be considered on an individual basis as far as grade point average is concerned.
- 4. Student must submit a <u>grade transcript/report</u> at the end of the fall semester, however at the end of the current academic year, an official transcript must be submitted to the Trust Fund to review hours and grades.
- 5. Student must keep the Trust Fund <u>notified of</u> current mailing address and must report in writing <u>any changes</u> in student's personal circumstances, which may affect student's ability to continue in college.
- 6. <u>Deadlines are very important</u>. It is the student's <u>responsibility</u> to make sure the application form and all supporting documents are submitted on time. If the student <u>does not</u> meet a certain deadline, the application will automatically be declined. The Trust Fund does not mail out <u>reminders</u>.
- 7. This scholarship is <u>renewable</u> annually for up to four years <u>providing that all existing</u> <u>criteria are met</u>. In cases where the course of study requires more than four years, the scholarship will be awarded accordance with the requirements of that particular course of study.
- 8. Renewal applications may be obtained at our office after December 1st of every year. Applications will not be mailed. <u>REMEMBER</u>, <u>ALL SCHOLARSHIPS MUST BE RENEWED</u> <u>EVERY YEAR</u>.
