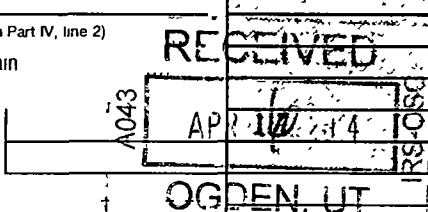

EXPLANATION

ON JANUARY 5, 2012, THE ORACLE EDUCATION FOUNDATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS DECIDED TO SUNSET THE FOUNDATION'S LARGEST PROGRAM (THINKQUEST) AND APPROVED AN 18-MONTH TRANSITION PLAN TO RESPONSIBLY WIND IT DOWN. AFTER THAT, THE FOUNDATION WAS TO ENTER A QUIET PERIOD DURING WHICH IT WOULD RESEARCH AND EVOLVE A NEW MISSION. THIS IS ONGOING. THE FOUNDATION IS FUNDED ANNUALLY WITH CASH. SINCE EXPENSES WERE ANTICIPATED TO BE LOW DURING THE QUIET PERIOD, NEW FUNDING WAS NOT REQUESTED FROM ITS SOLE DONOR, ORACLE, AS IT WOULD OPERATE WITH CASH ON HAND.

THE SUBSTANTIAL DECREASE IN ASSETS WAS A FUNCTION OF NORMAL THINKQUEST-RELATED GRANTS AND CONTRIBUTIONS PAID OUT DURING THE SUNSET, IN COMBINATION WITH THE FACT THAT NEW FUNDING WAS NOT REQUESTED. SEE FORM 990-PF, PART XV, LINE 3A FOR NAMES AND ADDRESSES OF ALL RECIPIENTS OF ASSETS.
