Staff would report the issue to the Foundation's President. Steps would then be taken to determine whether a conflict or the potential for conflict exists, and whether to. (1) take no action, (2) assure full disclosure to the Board, committee or others; (3) ask the individual to recuse him/herself from participation in discussions or decision making concerning the matter at hand, or (4) ask the individual to resign from his or her position or, if the individual refuses to resign, become subject to possible removal in accordance with the Foundation's bylaws. The Foundation's President and Vice President Finance monitor proposed and ongoing transactions for conflicts of interest and would disclose them to the Chair of the Audit Committee and Chair of the Board of Trustees in order to deal with potential or actual conflicts, whether discovered before or after the transaction has occurred
