1. ORGANIZATION AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

- A. The Brooklyn Waterfront Artists Coalition is a not-for-profit membership organization, the purpose of which is to help emerging artists advance in their careers by presenting their work to metropolitan art lovers in free exhibits. The accompanying financial statements reflect the revenue, expenses, assets, liabilities and net assets of the organization. The organization is exempt from federal taxes under section 501 (c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code (the "Code") and from state and local taxes under comparable laws.
- B. The accompanying financial statements of the Organization have been prepared on the accrual basis of accounting and conform to accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America as applicable to not-for-profit entities.
- C. The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, revenue and expenses and disclosure of contingencies. Actual results may differ from these estimates.
- D. All sales are recorded when the items are delivered to the customers.
- E. Property and equipment is recorded at cost. Major additions are capitalized. Depreciation is provided for using the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of three to ten years for furniture and equipment and three to five year for data processing systems.
- F. At year end, the net assets of the Organization are unrestricted.
- G. Contributions are recorded as revenue upon the receipt of cash or unconditional pledges. Contributions are considered available for unrestricted use unless specifically restricted by the donor.
- H. The organization receives dues from its members. Dues received for the current year's membership are recognized as revenue in the current year. Dues are recognized as income when collected.

THE BROOKLYN WATERFRONT ARTISTS COALITION NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AS AT JUNE 30, 2013

- I. Costs of promotions and advertising are expensed as incurred. For the fiscal year ended June 30, 2013 the advertising expense amounted to \$17,907.
- J. Cash includes certificate of deposits which bear interest at 4.7% per annum and mature within three months.
- K. Financial instruments that potentially subject the Company to concentrations of credit risk consist principally of cash and cash equivalent accounts in financial institutions, which from time to time exceed the Federal depository insurance coverage limit. Cash and cash equivalents exceeded federal limits.
- Expenditures are allocated to program, fund raising, general and administrative expenses based upon management's estimate of the expense.

2. <u>MEMBER SERVICES/MEMBER EXHIBIT SERVICES</u>

Members are required to put in between 16-40 hours of work to be in the exhibits. The exact number is determined by the number of shows in which they exhibit. Members also have the option of paying a work waiver fee of \$10.00 per hour. For the fiscal year ended June 30, 2013, member services and its related expense approximated \$99,720.

3. DONATED SPACE/RENT EXPENSE

Donated space and rent expense of \$264,000 are for exhibits and was calculated at estimated rental value of the 26,400 square feet of space utilized.

4. SUBSEQUENT EVENT

Management has evaluated subsequent events through February 4, 2014, which is the date the financial statements were available to be issued. They had no effect on the current financial statements.

Fair Value Hierarchy

The Fair Value Measurements Topic of the FASB Accounting Standards Codification establishes a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active market for identical assets or liabilities (Level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to measurements involving significant unobservable inputs (Level 3 measurements). The three levels of fair value hierarchy are as follows:

Level 1 inputs are quoted prices (unadjusted) in active markets for identical assets or liabilities that the Organization has the ability to access at the measurement date.

Level 2 inputs are inputs other than quoted prices included within Level 1 that are observable for the asset or liability directly or indirectly.

Level 3 inputs are unobservable inputs for asset or liability.

Determination of Fair Value

Under the Fair Value Measurements Topic of the FASB Accounting Standards Codification, the Organization bases its fair value on the price that would be received to sell and asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. It is the Organization's policy to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize use of unobservable inputs when developing fair value measurements, in accordance with the fair value hierarchy.

<u>Cash and Cash Equivalents, Accounts Receivable, Pledges Receivable, Grants Receivable and Accounts Payable</u>

The carrying amounts approximate fair value because of the short maturity of these instruments.
