our services. During the fiscal year, we provided 2,305 individual counseling sessions to adult victims, and 195 adult clients participated in support groups. We provided 430 individual counseling sessions to children, and children participated in our "Robbie's Room" art therapy Through our collaboration with Child Protective Services, group 298 times. we provided counseling and advocacy to 678 caregivers who care for 1,271 children. Our Self-Sufficiency Program helps victims overcome barriers to education and employment through goal planning, skill-building workshops, and referrals to employment and education. During the year, 217 clients were served, who received over 295 referrals for education / employment support or other assistance. The Human Trafficking Program serves victims of sex and labor trafficking, including victims of any age, gender identity, and immigration status. During the year, we provided direct services or technical assistance to smaller organizations on 63 cases of human trafficking. MSP is co-founder of the Westchester County Anti-Trafficking Task Force, a group of federal, state, and local law enforcement and service providers who convene to increase the number of investigations into trafficking cases and ensure appropriate referrals and service provision for victims.
