#### Explanation

PHILANTROPHY - The Asian American Community Fund, the Asian American Federations annual grant-making program, made \$225,000 to 19 grant awards. Since 1993, the Federation has supported critical programs for Asian American individuals and families through its Community Fund, awarded to local community organizations through a competitive application process. FY 2012-2013s awardees included Mekong to support staff to organize the Southeast Asian community in the Bronx, JASSI to assist Japanese seniors with mental health and entitlement services, and Council of Peoples Organization to develop afterschool programming for low-income Muslim youth in Brooklyn. On June 21, 2013, AAF hosted and worked with Mr. Bill Imada of the IW Group, Inc. who facilitated a training session focused on nonprofit branding at the Federations conference center. Opened to all Federation member agencies, the workshop focused on developing 4 core pillars: brand equity, brand personality, brand essence, and brand promise. Interpersonal exercises to improve creativity and spontaneity were conducted in break out groups for teams to collaboratively tell compelling stories about their mission and programs. AAF celebrated its 24th anniversary gala on May 2, 2013, honoring outstanding Asian American individuals and organizations as a way to kick off Asian American Pacific Heritage Month. AAF worked with our long-time partner and corporate supporter, News Corporation, to host a reception and private screening of the Academy Award nominated Life of Pi (in 3-D) on Tuesday, March 5, 2013 in their screening room of their corporate offices for AAFs loyal volunteers and supporters from employee network groups of various firms and corporate partners including Wells Fargo, Empire BlueCross BlueShield, Asian American Bar Association of NY, Wedding Creatives, and NBCUniversal. On February 27th, AAF and IW Group, an advertising agency focused on multicultural markets, hosted Here and Now II for our member agencies and local nonprofit community so they could meet corporate grant makers and learn more about fundraising and development strategies in todays changing times. Over 55 guests representing more than 40 agencies attended and took part in 4 hours of discussion, Q and A, and small group meetings with each individual funder Panelists included: Elva Lima, Executive Director, Community Relations and Multicultural Communications, Verizon Wireless; Don Lowery, Senior Vice President, Public Affairs and Government Relations, Nielsen; Liz Lyman, Managing Director and Head of Corporate Communications, The Bank of Tokyo-Mitsubishi UJF; Nandika Madgavkar, Senior Vice President, Communications, Citi Community Development and Microfinance; and Jewelle K. Yamada, Vice President, Corporate Communications, Sumitomo Corporation of America. AAF worked with The Asian Pacific American Medical Student Association at New Jersey Medical School to fundraise for Hurricane Sandy. What: Benefit Night for our Hurricane Sandy Relief Fund. Who: The Asian Pacific American Medical Student Association at New Jersey Medical School and the Asian American Federation. When: November 19th, 2012, 8PM. AAF worked on this 2nd year of bringing fun and laughter to disadvantaged Asian children and youth living in the New York City area with the Ong Family Foundation, the Yu Family Foundation and CACF for a night of dizzying delights and jaw-dropping spectacles for those who have never attended a circus, or whose families cannot afford to bring them at the Big Apple Circus-- over 1,600 immigrant or lower income families and children from our Asian communities.

PHILANTROPHY (CONTINUED) - To further cultivate our corporate partnership, AAF celebrated with its corporate partner Tiffany and company during its 175th anniversary in October 2012. Federation Board directors and donors were invited to attend an exclusive behind-the-scenes tour of the legendary companys 5th Avenue flagship store and network. -RESEARCH - Asian Americans of the Empire State: Growing Diversity and Common Needs was released in March of 2013. The report covers statewide and regional demographic changes. In addition, detailed socioeconomic indicators for New York City, the suburban counties surrounding New York City, and upstate counties with the largest Asian populations are presented. The report concludes with a summary of key demographic groups: the working poor, refugees, seniors, college and university populations and well-educated professionals. -HURRICANE SANDY RELIEF - Served as the liaison with FEMA and Asian American community groups working in the highest impacted neighborhoods after Hurrican Sandy. Reached out to community groups to identify needs in affected communities, barriers to community residents and businesses access to available relief resources, needs of local community organizations, as well as connect community groups to funders, government resources, and other agencies working in the hardest hit areas to ensure linguistically and culturally competent assistance. Reached out to elected officials of government agencies to inform them of existing issues and to facilitate their linkages with community based service providers. Convened a meeting with FEMA directors from 4 boroughs and community groups to discuss ongoing application challenges, understand FEMAs application process, including denials and appeals, and identified solutions to cultural barriers that prevent many New Yorkers from applying for assistance. Advocated for funding for agencies working in impacted areas with foundations, which resulted in over \$800,000 of assistance to member agencies. - LEADERSHIP OUTREACH - By invitation of the New York City Black, Latino, and Asian Caucus, provided demographic briefing on the Asian American population in New York City to the City Council. Discussion included the growing APA community that included a breakdown by council districts, ongoing challenges of the APA community, and how the Council and the APA community, through the Federation, can work together to provide services in our community. Several council members were interested in follow-up discussions. Served as one of the hosts of the White House Initiative on Asian Americans and Pacific Islanders (WHIAAPI) to arrange a listening tour with federal officials to Asian neighborhood in Queens. The delegation visited Woodside, Jackson Heights, Richmond Hill, and Flushing, and the tour concluded with a community reception at the Sheraton LaGuardia Hotel in Flushing.

-LEADERSHIP OUTREACH (CONTINUED) - Issues discussed during the neighborhood tour included data disaggregation, health care access and disparities, low-wage workers rights, education and anti-bullying efforts, immigration, housing assistance, and small business development. -CIVIC PARTICIPATION - Convened a broad based network of Asian American organizations, civic leaders, business owners, and concerned individuals to kick off a civic and community education campaign to further Asian American participation in the electoral process via Asian American Civic Alliance. Organized workshops on Campaign Finance Laws and Regulations in cooperation with community organizations and the New York City Campaign Finance Board. Hosted the Republican Mayoral Candidates Forum in at the CUNY Graduate Center, and the Democratic Mayoral Candidates Forum at the Time Warner Center in April 2013. Candidates discussed their plans and visions for the City, focusing on the areas of health and social services, small business, economic and community development, and education. The candidates also addressed the growth of Citys Asian Americans. - PROGRAM EFFORTS - Working with Lilly, Inc., hosted discussions on Asian seniors, depression and mental health issues. The community organizations will be convened regularly to form a working group to tackle issues impacting Asian seniors. Served as policy advisor to AARP-NY, specifically dealing with hunger and food access.
