# Statement of Program Service Accomplishments July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013

Volunteer Garden Program and Funding of Trees to Beautify Liberty State Park
Over 5 million people a year visit LSP from around our state, nation and the world and
therefore benefit from seeing the attractive plantings and trees throughout this urban
waterfront park behind Lady Liberty and Ellis Island. The beauty of LSP has a positive
impact on people's emotional, mental and spiritual health. We again focused on carrying out
our beautification and conservation goals, by purchasing trees, plants, shrubs, flowers, and flower
bulbs to beautify Liberty State Park. Almost every Saturday morning all year, we had gardening
volunteers. Middle of the week volunteers, mostly corporate groups, also did volunteering. Our
volunteers planted everything, except the trees we funded, and also did a tremendous amount of

Massive Cleanup after Superstorm Sandy – Friends' spearheaded the organizing of 11/17 clean up with mass emails/calls/press reach out/having refreshments for over 400 volunteers who came to help remove massive park debris after terrible flooding/winds.

Salt Marsh Clean up 4/6 (18th annual) Over 70 volunteers cleaned up LSP Salt Marsh.

Group Picnic Pavilions Field completed with help from FOLSP grant (\$57,900, the second reimbursement of the \$200,000 grant received from Hudson County) which we conveyed to NJDEP to help construct this \$1.8 million amenity for LSP.

Co-sponsored Hudson County Earth Day Festival on April 20, 2013 at LSP and participated in City of Water Day Festival on July 20. Info tables at both festivals.

### **Annual Walk for Liberty State Park 2013**

We co-sponsored our 9th fundraising WALK in LSP on April 20. The Walk's purpose was to raise money to spend on park plantings, etc. and raise public awareness about LSP as a recreational resource. The event was successful as we raised funds from sponsors and from our members who walked and obtained pledges for their walk.

#### **Annual Luncheon 2013**

We had our 8th fundraising Recognition Luncheon on 5/5/13 and it was an inspiring gathering. We honored park leaders and dedicated volunteers. Over 150 people again attended and we had positive publicity in the local newspapers.
